DAY 1 INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT - FRANKFURT

Arrival at Frankfurt International Airport. Reception at the airport and transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon, visit the center of Frankfurt, not forgetting the Römer Square and the center of the old city where the town hall (Rathaus) is, with its typical architecture. Take a walk down the Zeil street where you can find exclusive shops like Hollister or department stores. Finally go for a walk along the River Main ... Unforgettable!

DAY 2 FRANKFURT - ERFURT

 Breakfast at the hotel. According to your schedule, go to the train station to take your train to Erfurt, the capital of the state of Thuringia and known as Martin Luther was a monk in the Augustinian monastery in town. A car will be waiting for you to take you to the hotel. After a short break, we suggest you to explore the city. Located just 50 km to the southeast of the geographical center of Germany, is the country's most central metropolis. Visit also two of the many churches in the city, the cathedral and the church of San Severino. Overnight in Erfurt. (B)

DAY 3 ERFURT - BERLIN

 Departure after breakfast to the capital of Germany. You'll go to the train station for your ride to Berlin. Upon your arrival, transfer by private car to your hotel in the city. Once at the hotel, check in the selected hotel and in the afternoon, you have a walking tour in the program. With a local guide, you'll walk through the main attractions of the city divided until 1989, and a symbol of reunification: Brandenburg Gate, Postdamplatz, Alexanderplatz, Kurfürstendamm ... and the remains of the wall that divided the city until 1989. At dusk we recommend you visit the Sony Center and enjoy German cuisine. Overnight. (B)

DAY 4 BERLIN

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy today a guided introduction to its major sights in a walking city tour: the Brandenburg Gate, the Reichstag, Checkpoint Charlie, the German Parliament (Reichstag), and the grand boulevard of Kurfürstendamm. Afternoon free. Visit the Charlottenburg Castle, where you can see the grandeur of the Imperial Germany during the XVI and XVII centuries. We suggest also to visit the Museum of the concentration camp of World War II showing the development of

DAY 5 BERLIN - POTSDAM

Breakfast at the hotel. Today we will offer you a guided tour to the city of Potsdam, the capital of the State of Brandenburg, south from Berlin Center. Potsdam has several claims to national and international notability. In Germany, it had the status Windsor has in Britain because it was residence of Prussian kings and German Kaisers, until 1918. Around the city there are a series of interconnected lakes and unique cultural landmarks, in particular the parks and palaces of Sanssouci, the largest World Heritage Site in Germany, place that is included in our city tour. After visiting the park, return to Berlin. Overnight. (B)

DAY 6 BERLIN - DRESDEN - PRAGUE



Breakfast and departure by train for Dresden, the former capital of Saxony, along the River Elbe, which was largely destroyed during bombing in World War II. Visit the center of this beautiful imperial city, its castle, its narrow streets around the cathedral and the Semper Opera. Visiting the building is worth. Continue to the Czech Republic by train to reach Prague. Once at the train station, your car will be waiting for you in order to drive you to the hotel. Overnight. (B)

DAY 7 PRAGUE

Breakfast. You will meet your local guide who will show you the city visiting the Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, the picturesque Lower Town "Mala Strana", Victory Church of the Infant, Jesus of Prague, Charles Bridge, Old Town Square and Astronomical Clock. Free afternoon.

DAY 8 PRAGUE - VIENNA



Breakfast. Morning departure by train to the city of Vienna, Central European city on the banks of the Danube, in the valley of the Vienna woods, at the foothills of the Alps. The historic center of the Austrian capital declared World Heritage by UNESCO, noting first that its architectural and urban qualities represent an outstanding testimony of a continuous exchange of values throughout the second millennium. Since the 16th century Vienna has been universally recognized as the "musical capital of Europe." At your arrival, you will find your vehicle waiting to drive you to the selected hotel. Free afternoon. Overnight in Vienna (B)

DAY 9 VIENNA

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning guided visit to Vienna, visiting the Belvedere Palace, the Opera House, Royal Palace, City Hall, Votive Church, Hofburg, Stephansdom Cathedral and more. Afternoon free for optional excursions: Visit the Schönbrunn Palace or take a tour to see Grinzing, town famous for its wine taverns and green. Accommodation. (B)

DAY 10 VIENNA - BUDAPEST



After breakfast, take the scheduled train to Budapest, capital of Hungary. Budapest hosted the Hungarian royalty in various occupations in the Middle Ages, the Renaissance, the modern and contemporary era until 1944 when the monarchy disappeared in Hungary. After arrival in the city, transfer by private car to your hotel. Check in and rest of the day at leisure for private activities. Accommodation. (B)

DAY 11 BUDAPEST

Breakfast. Sightseeing tour of the city that is divided into two areas, "Buddha" where the old city is located and "Pest" modern and commercial area. We begin with the Buda castle hill to watch the vast Danube and the Pest extension. We walk around the old quarter to learn about the origins of the city through Matthias Cathedral, symbol of the most glorious days of Hungary, The Fishermen's Bastion, etc. Accommodation in Budapest. (B)

DAY 12 BUDAPEST - ZAGREB



Breakfast. The tour continues through Hungary towards Croatia. Our next destination is the city of Zagreb, the Croatian capital and the country's largest center. Take your scheduled train at the given time and upon arrival, we will be waiting for you to take you to your hotel. Check-in at the Hotel. In the afternoon, guided visit of the historic old town with its main attractions. Accommodation. (B)





DAY 13 ZAGREB - POREC



Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to the beautiful town of Porec Adriatic seaside, where you can relax after the busy days. Situated on the western coast of Istria County in Croatia, Porec offers in his 37 km of coastline endless possibilities for relaxation and water sports. Visit the historical center and enjoy the sea and the beach. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 14 POREC - VENICE

DAY 16 VENICE - VERONA - FLORENCE



Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Verona, one of the most attractive and interesting cities of Italy and the Veneto region, known for the story of Romeo and Juliet. Enter the city and visit its historic center, especially the Roman Arena and Juliet's house (after Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet) where you can leave your testimony of love. In the afternoon, go back to the train station and head to Florence. Arriving in the city, our vehicle will take you to your selected hotel. Check-in at the hotel. Rest of the day free. **(B)**

DAY 17 FLORENCE

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning guided tour of the city that is the cradle of the Renaissance and the Italian language. Stroll through this city of art, history and culture, admiring the Cathedral of Santa Maria dei Fiori with its beautifully decorated Campanile and the Baptistry with the famous Gates of Paradise, where such familiar persons as Michelangelo or Dante Alighieri went through. Overnight in Florence. **(B)**

DAY 18 FLORENCE

Breakfast at the hotel. Today we leave it to your own decision. The region is rich in destinations and we can help you to decide what to do. For example, visit Pisa with its famous leaning tower and baptistry, or head a little in the Cinque Terra and visit one of the fishing villages of the region such as Pontovenere. Interested in Tuscany and Wine Tasting? Let us know your decision at the moment of booking. Return to Florence. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 19 FLORENCE - ROME



Breakfast. Morning departure for Rome. Arriving in the city, transfer by car to the hotel. Check-in at the hotel. Afternoon guided tour of the Imperial City, visiting the Roman Forum, Colosseum, Arch of Constantine, Piazza Venezia and the famous Trevi Fountain. The rest of the day at your disposal for private activities. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 20 ROME

Breakfast at the hotel. Save the day to visit St. Peter's Square in the city-state of the Vatican, the Basilica of St. Peter and the Vatican museums and the famous work of Michelangelo, the Sistine Chapel. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 21 ROME

Breakfast. Day at leisure. We suggest to visit the Catacombs of St. Callixtus on the outskirts of Rome or to take a trip to Naples, a city near the Vesuvius volcano that buried the city of Pompeii in 79 AD, or visit the Isle of Capri that because of its natural beauty captivated the Roman Emperors. You still have one day train use and you can take any of these tours by train. **(B)**

DAY 22 ROME - AIRPORT

Breakfast. To the given time we will take you to the Rome airport for your flight back home or next destination in Europe. End of our services.
