## DAY 1 QUITO ARRIVAL IN QUITO

Upon arrival at Mariscal Sucre International Airport, you will be met by our team and transferred privately to your boutique hotel, located in the heart of Quito's Historic Center. The remainder of the day is at leisure to acclimate to the altitude, rest, or begin discovering the essence of Quito at your own pace.

## DAY 2 QUITO – AMAZON RAINFOREST (LA SELVA ECO-LODGE)

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to the Ecuadorian Amazon. Following a scenic flight and a river transfer, arrival at La Selva Eco-Lodge, one of the country's most exclusive lodges, located within the Yasuní Biosphere Reserve. Welcome reception and first immersion into the Amazon environment, surrounded by pristine rainforest and extraordinary biodiversity. Overnight at the La Selva Eco-Lodge (B)

## DAY 3 AMAZON Rainforest experiences

Breakfast at the lodge. A full day dedicated to exploring the Amazon rainforest, accompanied by specialized naturalist guides. Activities include guided walks through primary rainforest, navigation along rivers and lagoons, wildlife observation, and encounters with ancestral cultures that inhabit the region. Accommodation at La Selva Eco-Lodge. (B)

## DAY 4 AMAZON Nature and biodiversity

Breakfast at the lodge. Continuation of Amazon experiences in one of the most biodiverse ecosystems on the planet. Early-morning excursions, birdwatching, exploration of natural trails, and activities designed to foster an authentic connection with nature and the local environment. Accommodation at La Selva Eco-Lodge. (B)

## DAY 5 AMAZON – QUITO Historic city tour

Breakfast at the lodge. Return to Quito and guided visit of its Historic Center, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The tour includes the magnificent Church of La Compañía de Jesús, the architectural complex of San Francisco, and the Panecillo Viewpoint, offering panoramic views of the city. Lunch at a carefully selected local restaurant. Accommodation at the Illa Experience Hotel – Luxury Room or similar. (B) (L)

## DAY 6 QUITO - OTAVALO – QUITO Anden markets

Breakfast at the hotel. Full-day excursion to northern Ecuador, traveling through traditional Andean landscapes. Stop in Cayambe to taste the famous *bizcochos*, visit the Otavalo Market,

The journey continues to Cotacachi and the spectacular Cuicocha Lagoon, located within a volcanic crater. Return to Quito in the late evening. Accommodation at the Illa Experience Hotel – Luxury Room or similar. **(B) (L)**

#### DAY 7 QUITO – COTOPAXI NATIONAL PARK

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to the iconic Cotopaxi National Park, dominated by one of the world's highest active volcanoes. A gentle walk around Limpiopungo Lagoon and time to admire the Andean scenery. Lunch at Tambopaxi Lodge, followed by a gourmet dinner experience at the historic Hacienda San Agustín de Callo. Accommodation at the Hacienda San Agustín de Callo – Gordas / Geodesic / French Rooms or similar. **(B) (L)**

#### DAY 8 AVENUE OF THE VOLCANOES – CHIMBORAZO – RIOBAMBA

Breakfast at the hotel. Scenic journey along the legendary Avenue of the Volcanoes, including a visit to Chimborazo National Park, home to the point on Earth closest to the sun. Cultural encounter with the La Moya Community, featuring a traditional lunch and insight into Andean lifestyle. Dinner at the hacienda restaurant. Accommodation at the Hacienda La Andaluza – Suite or similar. **(B) (L)**

#### DAY 9 RIOBAMBA – INGAPIRCA – CUENCA

Breakfast at the hotel. Historic route through the central Andes. Visit Colta Lagoon, the Balbanera Church, the oldest church in Ecuador, and continue to the Ingapirca Archaeological Complex, the most important Inca site in the country. Arrival in Cuenca. Accommodation at the Hotel Itza – Junior Suite with Balcony or similar. **(B) (L)**

#### DAY 10 CUENCA Heritage city tour

Breakfast at the hotel. Guided tour of Cuenca, one of South America's most elegant colonial cities. The visit includes the Old and New Cathedrals, the Central Bank Museum, artisan guitar workshops, and the Panama Hat Museum. The tour also features the Flower Plaza and El Turi Viewpoint. Gastronomic experience lunch at Los Tiestos restaurant. Accommodation at the Hotel Itza – Junior Suite with Balcony or similar. **(B) (L)**

#### DAY 11 CUENCA – EL CAJAS – GUAYAQUIL

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Guayaquil, crossing El Cajas National Park, renowned for its lagoons and high-altitude páramo landscapes. Agro-productive experience at a cacao and mango hacienda, including lunch. Arrival in Guayaquil and panoramic city tour of the main highlights. Accommodation at the Hotel del Parque – Deluxe Room or similar. **(B) (L)**

#### DAY 12: GUAYAQUIL – GALÁPAGOS ISLANDS

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for the flight to the Galápagos Islands and embarkation on the selected cruise, beginning one of the world's most extraordinary natural experiences. Overnight on board. **(B) (L)**
