Between vineyard visits, you'll wander through olive groves, stroll the cobbled streets of **Nafplio** — **Greece's** first capital — and explore ancient sanctuaries like **Delphi**, where the oracle once whispered secrets of gods and men. The journey balances hands-on wine experiences with rich cultural immersion, designed to appeal to both wine enthusiasts and travelers who crave history, architecture, and authentic local life.

In this tour, every detail is crafted to give you flexibility, whether you are casual wine lover or seasoned connoisseur. Premium experiences, like a sunset cruise along the **Argolic Gulf** or a private tasting in a centuries-old wine cellar, allow you to tailor the trip to each group's tastes. By the end of the week, you'll have not only tasted some of **Greece's** finest wines but also absorbed the rhythms of the land and the stories that have made it one of the world's most compelling wine destinations. DAY 1 ATHENS Arrival in Greece.

Kalimera!!! Welcome to Athens. After your flight, your private driver meets you at the airport and whisks you to your hotel in the charming Plaka district. Step inside, drop your luggage, and take a moment to rejuvenate from the long haul. As the afternoon light softens, wander the winding streets of Plaka, where cafes spill onto cobblestone lanes and the distant silhouette of the Acropolis promises adventure. In the evening, settle into a traditional taverna for a welcome dinner. Sample local mezze — olives, cheeses, fresh seafood — paired with crisp Assyrtiko and floral Moschofilero, setting the tone for the week ahead. Overnight in Athens. (D)

DAY 2 ATHENS Cradle of civilization and urban wines

Begin your day with breakfast at the hotel, savoring Greek yogurt, honey, and fresh fruit. Then, meet your private guide for a morning tour of the Acropolis. Wander beneath the Parthenon and soak in the panoramic views of Athens, while stories of gods, myths, and philosophers intertwine with the city's living history. Afterward, enjoy lunch at a rooftop restaurant overlooking the ancient monuments, paired with delicate white and rosé wines. The afternoon brings a private tasting at a boutique urban winery, where you explore Assyrtiko, Aidani, and Athiri, learning the secrets of Greece's unique terroir. Dinner is at leisure, allowing you to follow your guide's suggestions for hidden gem tavernas or modern Greek bistros. Overnight in Athens. (B) (L)

DAY 3 ATHENS - NAFPLIO Agiorgitiko Country

After breakfast, your private driver escorts you through the scenic countryside toward Nemea, the heart of Greece's red wine country. Rolling hills and olive groves line the way, offering glimpses of timeless landscapes. Upon arrival, enjoy a farm-to-table lunch at a local estate, paired with rich Agiorgitiko reds. In the afternoon, visit two family-owned wineries, wandering vineyards and exploring cool, earthy cellars. At one estate, experience an exclusive cellar tour, guided by the winemaker, exploring aged barrels, hidden reserves, and learning the secrets of production that only insiders usually see. Taste the depth of Agiorgitiko, comparing traditional and modern winemaking styles while learning about grape cultivation and the region's history. As the day winds down, check in at your hotel in Nafplio, a coastal town of elegant streets and Venetian architecture. To close the day in style, embark on a sunset cruise along the Argolic Gulf, watching the sun sink into the Aegean as the gentle waves lap against the hull. Overnight in Nafplio. **(B) (L)**

DAY 4 NAFPLIO Culture and coast

Breakfast at your hotel prepares you for a morning exploring Nafplio's old town. Climb the steps to Palamidi Fortress for sweeping views of the bay, and stroll through Syntagma Square, where history and daily life intertwine. In the afternoon, visit the nearby ancient site of Mycenae and the theater of Epidaurus, marveling at ruins where myths were born. Conclude the day with a tasting at a boutique vineyard producing aromatic Moschofilero and Malagousia, deepening your appreciation of the region's whites. The evening is free for wandering Nafplio's charming streets, lingering at cafés, or enjoying additional wine tastings at your leisure. Overnight in Nafplio. **(B)**

DAY 5 NAFPLIO – MANTINIA Aromatic white wines

After breakfast, drive north to the Mantinia region, famous for its fragrant white varietals. Arrive in time for a lunch at a winery, enjoying a selection of cheeses, charcuterie, and local specialties paired with Moschofilero, Malagousia, and other aromatic whites. In the afternoon, explore the vineyards on foot, learning about the challenges and rewards of cultivating grapes at higher altitudes. Participate in an optional blending session, creating your own Moschofilero cuvée under the guidance of the winemaker. After the visit, return to Nafplio to your hotel. Then, you can have dinner (not included) at the hotel or a nearby tavern, accompanied by locally produced wines, while the rolling hills glow in the evening light. Overnight in Nafplio. **(B) (L)**

DAY 6 NAFPLIO - DELPHI – ATHENS Sacred landscapes and wine

Breakfast is followed by a scenic drive to Delphi, with stops along the way at olive groves and quaint villages. In the afternoon, explore the archaeological site of Delphi, standing where ancient Greeks sought wisdom from the oracle. Walk through the Temple of Apollo and the nearby museum, reflecting on the spiritual and cultural significance of wine in ancient times. Before returning to Athens, visit a small nearby winery for a tasting of limited-production Malagousia and Xinomavro. Arrive in Athens in the evening for a farewell dinner at a stylish restaurant, where a curated wine pairing highlights the week's journey. Overnight in Athens. **(B) (D)**

DAY 7 ATHENS Departure

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a final stroll through Athens or a quick visit to a local market for souvenirs. Your private driver transfers you to Athens International Airport for your departure, leaving you with memories of sun-soaked vineyards, ancient ruins, and the timeless beauty of Greece. End of our services. **(B)**
