DAY 1 ISTANBUL Arrival day

DAY 2 ISTANBUL City tour

After breakfast, we have Istanbul City Tour. Our first visit will be the ancient Hippodrome, witness of the scene of chariot races, with the three monuments; the Obelisk of Theodosius, the bronze Serpentine Column and the Column of Constantine. Then, we will visit the Sultanahmet Imperial Mosque. Across from Hagia Sophia Grand Mosque, it was built in the 16th century by the architect Mehmet, is known as the BLUE MOSQUE because of its magnificent interior decoration of blue Iznik tiles. Our next visit will be the Hagia Sophia Grand Mosque, previously known as the Church of Divine Wisdom, is simply the best of its kind! Hagia Sophia Grand Mosque is the greatest surviving example of Byzantine Architecture. For 1000 years, it was once the largest church in the world, decorated with stunning 6th century golden mosaics. End of the entertainment at about midnight and transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Istanbul.

DAY 3 ISTANBUL – KUSADASI Bosphorus cruise & domestic flight

After breakfast enjoy the BOSPHORUS BY BOAT, a traditional excursion by boat along the waterway separating Europe and Asia. The shore lined with old wooden villas, palaces of marble, fortresses, and small fishing villages. During the excursion, you will see the magnificent sights of the following attractions from your boat: See Dolmabahce Palace, and further along, the parks and imperial pavilions of Yildiz Palace. On the coastal edge of this park, is Ciragan Palace, 300 meters of its marble facade faces the shore. At Ortakoy a great variety of artists, gather every sunday to display their work along the street. Ortakoy is a symbol of tolerance with a church, a mosque and a synagogue existing side by side for centuries. RUMELI FORTRESS (view from boat), Built by Mehmet the Conqueror in 1452 prior to the conquest of Istanbul was completed in only four months to control and protect the infamous Bosphorus passage. It is one of the most beautiful works of military architecture anywhere in the world. BEYLERBEYI PALACE (view from boat), is the summer residence of Ottoman sultans exists in its original renovated glory featuring original antique furniture and magnificent gardens with the Harem on the Asian side of Istanbul. Lunch break at the Turkish restaurant. After lunch we will take you to the GRAND SPICE BAZAAR, which is a unique atmosphere with reasonable prices for your shopping. Here you will find exotic Spices and Herbs, Turkish Baklava, Turkish Delights, Turkish Coffee, nuts and fruits, small souvenirs such as Ceramic Handicrafts, Evil Eyes totems, all naturel olive oil, soaps and many other goods in Souvenir Shops and stores. After the tour transfer to Istanbul Airport for domestic flight to Izmir. Transfer from the airport and check in to your hotel in Kusadasi. Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi. (B) (D)

DAY 4 EPHESUS Ancient City & Sirince Village

After breakfast, departure from hotel to a fully guided tour of Ephesus, one of the best-preserved ancient sites in the world, visiting en-route the Temple of Artemis, Curetes street, famous Roman baths, Celsus Library and Grand theatre. Lunch break. After lunch, we will visit a place, which continues to perform one of the oldest arts of Turkey; a carpet-weaving centre. After lunch, we will do a Turkish Village Tour. Sirince's construction style today belongs to Anatolian Greeks. The houses on the slope are all original with their white paints. Sirince Village also has a fantastic reputation for making some of the best wines in Turkey - especially fruit wines. We will see the vineyards and it is time to learn how to make fruit wine. In the evening, you will be tested about your knowledge of making fruit wine. On the way, we will visit one of the famous leather production centers of the region. Overnight in Kusadasi.

DAY 5 PAMUKKALE – HIERAPOLIS

We depart for Pamukkale at 08:00 am. Upon arrival to Pamukkale we have a lunch break. Afterwards we shall visit the calcium terraces of Pamukkale (cotton castle) and the ruins of Hierapolis, then walk around this natural phenomenon and have the option of lying in the waters of the natural springs. Denizli/Pamukkale means seaside in Turkish and is located on the Buyuk Menderes River. It is a growing industrial town, known for its textile industry and outlet shopping. You will visit one of the famous textile factories of Pamukkale. We will stay in the thermal hotel, which has the most beautiful natural hot water, and you can enjoy the hot thermal pool in the hotel. Overnight. (B)





DAY 6 PAMUKKALE – ANTALYA

For our dear guests who experience the Hot Air Balloon Tour in Pamukkale, we will depart to the area where balloons take-off at 05:30 in the morning. From the Balloon, you will witness the magnificent and unique view of nature by viewing the morning sunrise over the ancient city of Hierapolis and Cotton White Travertines which is listed as one of the best 7 wonders of the world and registered in the UNESCO heritage list. After the Hot Air Balloon Excursion, we will celebrate our landing with champagne ceremony and return to the hotel for a delicious breakfast. After breakfast, at 10:00m we depart for Antalya. Upon arrival, check-in at the hotel and free time for private activities. Overnight in Antalya. (B)

DAY 7 ANTALYA Old City & Waterfalls

After breakfast drive to Antalya Old City (Kaleici), Marina, Clock Tower, Hadrian's Gate, Broken Minaret, Hıdırlık Tower: Kaleici is a small historic part of Antalya's modern city. In history it was once the sprawling modern Roman town, then the Byzantine Empire, then Seljuks, and finally the Ottoman Turkish town. The Hadrian's Gate is a triumphal arch which was built in the name of the Roman emperor Hadrian. Antalya's broken wonder is the Broken Minaret of the Korkut Mosque, which was built originally as a Roman temple in the 2nd century AD, and thus did not have a minaret at all. Hıdırlık Tower is a landmark tower of tawny stone in Antalya, Turkey, where Kaleici meets Karaalioglu Park. It is believed to be built in Hellenistic era on a square plan and later turned into circular tower in 2nd century AD and was used as either a fortification or a lighthouse in the past. After lunch depart for Duden Waterfalls. All the streams of the region aim at finding their way into the Mediterranean and they pour down the slopes of the Taurus, sometimes overland, sometimes underground and reaching their destination, resulting in lovely waterfalls, of which there are more than twenty. After the tour come back to hotel and rest of day is yours. (B)

DAY 8 ANTALYA – KONYA – CAPPADOCIA

After breakfast early in the morning drive to Konya, arriving on time for lunch. In the afternoon, we will visit the imposing green-tiled Mausoleum of Mevlana, the mystic founder of the Sufi sect (Whirling Dervishes). After the Konya Mevlana tour drive to Cappadocia. Arrival to Cappadocia around 18:30 pm. and check into your hotel. Note: If you wish to join our optional activity of Cappadocia Hot Air Ballooning for tomorrow, please contact your guide and register because it will take place early the next morning. Overnight in Cappadocia. (B)

OPTIONAL CAPPADOCIA TURKISH NIGHT SHOW. You may have great fun in the real caves, with the rich Anatolian food menu, unlimited local alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks, belly dance show, Turkish Folklore show, DJ Performance and warm service of Anatolian Hospitality.

DAY 9 CAPPADOCIA Underground City & Goreme

Optional: Hot Air Balloon Ride: Watch the sunrise over fairy chimneys—one of the world's most iconic ballooning experiences. After breakfast, we will visit Ozkonak underground city, built as early as the Hittite era and expanded by early Christians seeking refuge. Explore tunnels, storage rooms, wineries, ventilation shafts, and stone doors. Continue to the Goreme open air museum (UNESCO)

A monastic complex with rock-cut churches decorated with vivid frescoes from the 10th–12th centuries. Continue to the Cavusin Village, an abandoned Greek village known for its cave houses and scenic viewpoints. Next, we will visit Avanos, a pottery center since Hittite times, located along the Kizilirmak River. Enjoy a live pottery demonstration. And finally, we will go to Love Valley, Devrent Valley and Three Beauties, known for their unique fairy chimneys and whimsical rock formations shaped by erosion over millions of years.

DAY 10 CAPPADOCIA – ISTANBUL Departure

Breakfast at the hotel. At the given time transfer to Cappadocia Airport for your domestic flight to Istanbul and your international connection home. We hope you enjoyed a memorable journey!! End of our services. (B)
