From charming villages like **Sirince**, scented with fruit wines and tradition, to the legendary walls of **Troy** and the poignant battlefields of **Gallipoli**, each day deepens your connection to this remarkable land—its triumphs, its sorrows, and its timeless resilience.

The journey culminates in **Istanbul**, a city like no other, where continents meet and empires once ruled the world. Beneath the domes of Hagia Sophia and the Blue Mosque, amid bustling bazaars and historic squares, you feel the pulse of East and West beating as one. **Magic Turkey** is carefully crafted for travelers who want more than a holiday—those who seek meaning, beauty, and unforgettable moments. Join this 11-day adventure and let Turkey enchant you, inspire you, and stay with you long after the journey ends.

DAY 1 ARRIVAL IN ATHENS – FLIGHT TO CAPPADOCIA

Upon your arrival at Istanbul International Airport walk to Domestic terminal and take your connecting flight to Cappadocia. Your guide will meet, assist and transfer you to the hotel. Dinner and overnight in Cappadocia. **Please Note:** If you wish to join our optional activity of Cappadocia Hot Air Ballooning for tomorrow, please contact with your guide and register because it will take place early the next morning. **(D)**

DAY 2 CAPPADOCIA Tour with Underground City and Goreme Open Air Museum

Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast at 09:30 depart for Cappadocia Tour. We will drive you to Ozkonak Underground City, one of the best preserved Underground cities in Cappadocia. After the Underground City tour, you visit Goreme Open Air Museum, the Heart of Cappadocia. Goreme Open Air Museum is famous for frescoes dating to 10th century describing the life of Jesus Christ and monks. Next stop is Cavusin, which is an abandoned village with old cave Greek houses. After Cavusin you go to the restaurant in Avanos to have lunch. After lunch, you visit a pottery workshop, to see how to make pottery. Then you go to Love Valley. Love Valley Cappadocia is a hidden valley with scenic formations to say the least. Despite the resemblance to man hood, these amazing rock formations are far from man-made. Next stop is Devrent Valley, which is also called Imagination Valley, where you can see natural rock formations looking like animals. The last stop is Three Beauties, three beautiful fairy chimneys with their hats, which is the symbol of Cappadocia. This tour will end approximately at 17:00 - 18:00 and you will return to your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Cappadocia. **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 3 CAPPADOCIA – KONYA– ANTALYA

Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast early in the morning at 08:00 drive to Konya. Lunch at 13:30 pm at a local restaurant. After the lunch visit the imposing, green-tiled Mausoleum of Mevlana, the mystic founder of the Sufi sect (Whirling Dervishes). After the Konya Mevlana tour

DAY 4 ANTALYA Old City Tour and Waterfalls

After breakfast drive to Antalya Old City (Kaleiçi) Marina, Clock Tower, Hadrian's Gate, Broken Minaret, Hıdırlık Tower: Kaleici is a small historic part of Antalias modern city, also known as the Old City of Antalya. In history it was once the sprawling modern Roman town, then the Byzantine Empire, then Seljuks, and finally the Ottoman Turkish town. The Hadrian's Gate (or Hadrianus Gate or The Three Gates is a triumphal arch which was built in the name of the Roman emperor Hadrian. Antalya's broken wonder is the Broken Minaret of the Korkut Mosque, which itself was built originally as a Roman temple in the 2nd century AD, and thus did not have a minaret at all. Hıdırlık Tower is a landmark tower of tawny stone in Antalya, Turkey, where Kaleiçi meets Karaalioglu Park. It is believed to be built in the Hellenistic era on a square plan and later turned into a circular tower in 2nd century AD and was used as either a fortification or a lighthouse in the past. We have lunch at the hotel and then depart for Duden Waterfalls. All the streams of the region aim at finding their way into the Mediterranean and they pour down the slopes of the Taurus, sometimes overland sometimes underground and reaching their destination, result in lovely waterfalls, of which there are more than twenty. After the tour come back to hotel and rest of day is yours. Dinner and overnight in Antalya. **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 5 ANTALYA - PAMUKKALE

After breakfast, at 10:00 am. we depart for Pamukkale. The trip is going to take roughly 3 to 4 hours. Once you reach Pamukkale, check in to your hotel and rest of time is yours. Dinner and Overnight in Pamukkale. **(B) (D)**

DAY 6 PAMUKKALE - KUSADASI

Breakfast at the hotel. We shall visit the calcium terraces of Pamukkale (cotton castle) and the ruins of Hierapolis, then walk around this natural phenomenon and have the option of lying in the waters of the natural springs. Denizli/Pamukkale means seaside in Turkish and is located on the Buyuk Menderes River. It is a growing industrial town, known for its textile industry and outlet shopping. You will visit one of the famous textile factories of Pamukkale. After the tour drive to Kusadasi and check in your hotel. Dinner and Overnight in Kusadasi. **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 7 KUSADASI Ephesus Tour and Turkish Village Sirince

After breakfast between 08:30 am, departure from hotel fully guided tour of Ephesus, one of the best-preserved ancient sites in the world en - route, visiting the Temple of Artemis, Curetes street, famous Roman baths, Celsus Library and Grand theatre. Lunch break around 13:00 pm. After the lunch, we will visit a place, which continues to perform one of the oldest arts of Turkey; a carpet-weaving centre. After lunch, we will do a Turkish Village Tour. Sirince's construction style today belongs to Anatolian Greeks. The houses on the slope are all Original with their white paints. Sirince Village also has a fantastic reputation for making some of the best wines in Turkey - especially fruit wines. There will be some free time to explore around the village. On the way, we will visit one of the famous leather production centers of the region, where you will have the opportunity to get a good factory rate. On this guided tour, you will avoid the constant nagging and sometimes bullying that is well known in the markets of Turkey. Enabling you to enjoy the shopping experience whilst gaining the knowledge of the ancient craftsmen. Dinner and Overnight in Kusadasi. **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 8 KUSADASI – CANAKKALE Pergamon and Troy Tour

We depart at 08:30 and drive to Pergamon. At 10:30 we will be at Pergamon. Visit to the magnificent Bergama Museum. It is an impressive Museum, and you may see many important relics from Ancient Pergamon. Pergamon is a famous city for its jewelry, stones and silver. So on the way, we will visit a jewelry center for 30 minutes. Lunch break around 12:15 pm. and after lunch departure for Troy. Visit the famous archeological and mythological site of Troy, home of





the Trojan Horse and Helen of Troy. After the tour, check-in at the selected hotel and time at leisure for private activities. Dinner and Overnight in Canakkale. **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 9 CANAKKALE – GALLIPOLI - ISTANBUL

Breakfast at the hotel. At 08:00 or 08:30 am we depart for Gallipoli in order to visit the battlefields. Two hours later we will give you 20 minutes to relax in a restaurant area. We will arrive at Gallipoli around 12:00 pm. and we will have a lunch break, relax a little bit and then depart for the battlefields. Visit Gabatepe Museum. Start visiting the fields with Ariburnu Cemetery and Anzac Cove because these are the places where the war started. Then Beach Cemetery, Lone Pine and Chunuck Bair. After the tour we will drive you to the hotel in Istanbul. Bus Trip will take roughly 5 – 6-hours drive. Overnight in Istanbul. **(B) (L)**

DAY 10 ISTANBUL City tour

After breakfast, we have an Istanbul City Tour. Our first visit will be HIPPODROME. Ancient Hippodrome was the scene of chariot races, with the three monuments, the Obelisk of Theodosius, the bronze Serpentine Column and the Column of Constantine. Then we will visit SULTANAHMET IMPERIAL MOSQUE. Across from Hagia Sophia Grand Mosque, it was built in the 16th century by the architect Mehmet, is known as the BLUE MOSQUE because of its magnificent interior decoration of blue Iznik tiles. Our next visit will be HAGIA SOPHIA GRAND MOSQUE. The Hagia Sophia Grand Mosque, previously known as the Church of Divine Wisdom, is simply the best of its kind! Hagia Sophia Grand Mosque is the greatest surviving example of Byzantine Architecture. For 1000 years, it was once the largest church in the world, decorated with stunning 6th century golden mosaics. Today it is a mosque. Lunch break at 13:00 pm. After lunch, TravelShop Group will take you to the ALI PASAZADE which is a unique atmosphere with reasonable prices for your shopping. Here you will find; Exotic Spices and Herbs, Turkish Baklava, Turkish Delights, Turkish Coffee, nuts and fruits, small souvenirs such as Ceramic Handicrafts, Evil Eyes totems, all naturel olive oil, soaps and many other goods in Souvenir Shops and stores. After the tour, transfer back to your hotel. **Please Note:** Please do not forget to carry headscarf with you for the visit of religious places as Blue Mosque & Hagia Sophia Mosque. **(B) (L)**

DAY 11 (Wednesday) ISTANBUL - RETURN

Breakfast at the hotel. Free time in Istanbul for private activities. To agreed time, airport transfer for your return flight or connection for the extension of your trip. End of our services. **(B)**
