Discover the best of **Scandinavia** on this 10-day journey through **Denmark, Norway, Sweden, and Finland**. Perfectly designed for independent travelers who enjoy flexibility, comfort, and authentic experiences, this itinerary combines the rich cultural heritage of vibrant capitals with the breathtaking natural landscapes of fjords, mountains, and the Baltic Sea.

Your adventure begins in **Copenhagen**, Denmark's lively capital, where history and modernity merge. Stroll through the colorful canals of **Nyhavn**, admire the iconic Little Mermaid, and explore the city's royal heritage at **Christiansborg Palace**. Travel onward to **Roskilde** and **Helsingør** to visit **Denmark's** historic cathedral, Viking Ship Museum, and the legendary **Kronborg Castle**, immortalized in Shakespeare's *Hamlet*.

From **Denmark**, the journey crosses the **North Sea**. Board an overnight ferry from **Hirtshals** to **Stavanger, Norway**, allowing you to wake up refreshed on the Norwegian coast. Explore **Stavanger's** charming old town, then follow the fjord coast to **Lysefjord**, taking in dramatic cliffs and waterways. Continue to **Bergen**, Norway's "gateway to the fjords," and ride the funicular up **Mount Fløyen** for spectacular views of the city and surrounding fjords.

Experience the world-renowned **Norway in a Nutshell®** route, a carefully coordinated scenic transport system combining rail, fjord cruise, and panoramic journeys through some of **Norway's** most spectacular landscapes. **Oslo** offers a perfect mix of cultural landmarks, including the Royal Palace, Viking Ship Museum, Akershus Fortress, & the modern waterfront.

Crossing into **Sweden**, travel through **Örebro** to **Stockholm**, the city built on thirteen islands. Discover the charming streets of Gamla Stan, the Royal Palace, and the Nobel Museum, with panoramic views from **Fjällgatan**. From **Stockholm**, board an overnight ferry to **Turku, Finland**, sailing past the **Åland Islands** and across the **Baltic Sea**. Finish your journey in **Helsinki**, exploring the historic center, Market Square, and the iconic Rock Church before your departure.

This itinerary has been carefully structured for FIT travelers: using scheduled transport where possible, overnight travel to save time, and optional guided highlights in each city. DAY 1 INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT – COPENHAGEN Welcome to Scandinavia

Your journey begins as you arrive at Copenhagen Airport, where our local representative will welcome you to the Danish capital, a city renowned for its harmonious mix of history, design, and Scandinavian lifestyle. Copenhagen, originally a Viking fishing village in the 10th century, has evolved into a bustling metropolis that blends medieval charm with modern creativity. Transfer and short rest after check-in. Around noon, we will invite you to discover Copenhagen in vivid detail with us! Dive into a fairy-tale-inspired adventure as we explore the city's most iconic landmarks and their surrounding gems. We'll take you to the heart of Copenhagen's history and culture, from the Royal Palace of Amalienborg to the Little Mermaid herself. But that's not all—discover the stunning Gefion Fountain, stroll through the historic Citadel, Kastellet, and marvel at the lively charm of Nyhavn harbor. To top it off, we'll visit the impressive Christiansborg Slot, home to Denmark's Parliament. Rest of the afternoon at leisure to continue discovering the city or for shopping. Our recommendation: Visit Tivoli Park. Overnight in Copenhagen.

DAY 2 COPENHAGEN – HELSINBORG Castle of Hamlet & Vikings

After breakfast, enjoy a full-day tour outside of Copenhagen, exploring the picturesque landscapes of both farmland and city. The day begins at the authentic castle of Shakespeare's Hamlet, Kronborg. Walk through the castle from the 1600s century that it inspired Shakespeare to write Hamlet and impressing all of Europe with its architecture and engineering at that time. From here the journey will traverse through the beautiful North Zealand landscape, featuring forests and charming town of Hillerod, where you'll have the opportunity to explore the incredible renaissance architecture of Frederiksborg Palace at your own pace. Roskilde is the last stop of the day. We will visit the Roskilde Cathedral, gaining insights into its history and elaborating over Danish Christian history from Catholicism to Protestantism. This UNESCO Heritage site dating back a millennium is also serving as the final resting place for nearly all Danish Christian kings. In Roskilde, we'll also take you to the shores of Roskilde Fjord, where the Viking Ship Museum is situated. Explore the shipyard and small harbor filled with reconstructed Viking ships, especially active during the summer period from April to the end of September. In the museum itself you can walk around amongst the more than 1000-year-old wreck of real Viking ship while gaining more information about the exhibition at your own pace. Back to Copenhagen, time at leisure and overnight. (B)

DAY 3 COPENHAGEN – BERGEN Arrival in Norway's Coastal Gem

Breakfast at the hotel. After a relaxed morning in Copenhagen—perhaps enjoying a final stroll through its elegant streets or a quiet coffee in one of its stylish cafés—you will transfer to the airport for your onward flight to Norway. Your journey takes you across the North Sea to Bergen, a city dramatically set between mountains and fjords and widely regarded as the gateway to Norway's fjord region. Upon arrival, a comfortable transfer brings you to your centrally located hotel. Bergen immediately enchants with its unique blend of maritime heritage and natural beauty. If time allows, we recommend an evening walk through the historic Bryggen, where colorful wooden houses—once part of the Hanseatic trading empire—line the harbor. The soft coastal light, the scent of the sea, and the gentle rhythm of the port create a welcoming and atmospheric introduction to Norway. This is the perfect beginning to your fjord experience. Overnight. (B)

DAY 4 BERGEN - VOSS Norway in a Nutshell®. The Fjords Experience

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a leisurely morning in Bergen, one of Norway's most charming cities. You may wish to visit the lively fish market, browse local artisan boutiques, or take the Fløibanen to the top of Mount Fløyen for sweeping views over the city, fjords, and surrounding peaks. In the afternoon, you begin the renowned Norway in a Nutshell® journey—**not a traditional guided excursion, but a carefully coordinated system of scenic transport** that allows you to travel independently through some of Norway's most spectacular landscapes. Combining train and other modes of transport, this experience is designed to showcase the very best of the fjord region. As you leave Bergen behind, the scenery gradually transforms: lush valleys give way to dramatic mountains, waterfalls cascade down steep cliffs, and tranquil lakes reflect the surrounding peaks. Arrival in Voss, a peaceful village set amid lakes and mountains, where you will check in at your hotel. The slower pace and natural surroundings offer the perfect setting to relax and absorb the impressions of the day. Overnight in Voss. (B)

DAY 5 VOSS - FLÅM - OSLO Norway in a Nutshell®

Breakfast at the hotel. Today continues your journey through Norway's most iconic landscapes, as you complete the second stage of the Norway in a Nutshell® experience en route to Oslo. This remarkable route combines train, ferry and bus, each segment offering a different perspective on the region's natural beauty. One of the highlights is the descent on the famous Flåm Railway, one of the steepest and most scenic railway journeys in the world. In Flåm, you will board a fjord cruise through the breathtaking Nærøfjord, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where narrow waterways, towering cliffs and cascading waterfalls create an unforgettable panorama. As the journey continues inland, the dramatic fjord landscapes gradually give way to forests, lakes and open countryside before reaching Oslo. Upon arrival late at night, check-in at your hotel and have a nice rest. Norway's capital offers a striking contrast to the fjords, blending modern architecture, vibrant cultural life and easy access to nature. Overnight in Oslo. (B)





DAY 6 OSLO The Capital of Norway

Breakfast at the hotel. Discover Oslo's rich blend of culture, history, and nature. Begin at the Royal Palace Park, wandering among lush greenery and admiring the palace architecture. Continue to the Viking Ship Museum, showcasing extraordinary 9th-century vessels, and Bygdøy Peninsula, home to fascinating maritime museums. Explore Akershus Fortress, overlooking the Oslofjord. The afternoon is free to explore Oslo's galleries, shops, or take a walk along the vibrant waterfront. Overnight in Oslo. **(B)**

DAY 7 OSLO - STOCKHOLM Crossing the Swedish border

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a relaxed final morning in Oslo, making the most of your time in Norway's elegant capital before continuing east into Sweden. With a late-morning departure, there is ample opportunity to explore the city at your own pace or revisit a favorite spot from the previous day, like a gentle stroll along the Oslo waterfront, the Opera House, or a walk through the grounds of Akershus Fortress. At the appropriate time, make your way to Oslo Central Station, where you will board the direct high-speed train to Stockholm, departing at 11:46. This comfortable and efficient rail journey is one of the most pleasant ways to travel between the two Scandinavian capitals. Arrival in Stockholm is scheduled for the late afternoon, bringing you directly into the heart of Sweden's capital. Upon arrival, private transfer to your hotel and check in. The remainder of the day is free to begin discovering this beautiful city, built across islands connected by bridges and surrounded by water. Overnight in Stockholm. **(B)**

DAY 8 STOCKHOLM Stockholm sightseeing and ferry to Helsinki (Finland)

After breakfast, enjoy a final morning in Stockholm, beginning with a guided city tour that introduces the highlights of this beautiful Nordic capital, often described as one of the most scenic cities in Europe. Built across 14 islands and connected by bridges, Stockholm combines royal history, maritime heritage, and modern Scandinavian design. The tour takes you through the heart of the city, offering views of the Royal Palace, one of the largest palaces in Europe and the official residence of the Swedish monarchy. Continue to Gamla Stan, the charming medieval old town, where narrow cobblestone streets, colorful façades, and historic squares create a timeless atmosphere. You will also pass key landmarks such as the Parliament building, elegant waterfront areas, and selected viewpoints that highlight the city's unique relationship with water and nature. In the afternoon, at the scheduled time, transfer to the Stockholm ferry terminal to embark on the overnight ferry to Helsinki, departing at 16:00. As the ship leaves the harbor, enjoy spectacular views of Stockholm's archipelago, a maze of hundreds of islands, rocky islets, and forested shores—one of the most beautiful sea passages in the Baltic region. Overnight on board the ferry as you sail across the Baltic Sea toward Finland. **(B)**

DAY 9 HELSINKI

Arrival in Helsinki is scheduled for around 10:00 am, as the ferry gently enters the Finnish capital's harbor. Disembark and transfer to your hotel, where luggage can be stored if rooms are not yet available. The late morning is free, allowing you to begin discovering the city at your own pace or to relax after the overnight crossing. In the afternoon, meet your guide for a city tour, offering an introduction to the main landmarks and the city's distinctive architectural heritage. Highlights include the impressive Helsinki Cathedral, dominating Senate Square with its white neoclassical façade; the Uspenski Cathedral, a striking red-brick Orthodox church reflecting Finland's historical ties to Russia; and the National Library and surrounding civic buildings. The tour continues with a visit to the remarkable Rock Church (Temppeliaukio Church), carved directly into solid granite and famous for its natural acoustics and copper dome. You will also see areas showcasing Finland's reputation for contemporary design and urban innovation, as well as coastal districts that reveal the city's close relationship with the sea. Overnight in Helsinki. **(B)**

DAY 10 HELSINKI Return flight

You will be able to enjoy the city and do your last purchases before departure at the agreed time towards the airport in Helsinki for your return flight or connection to your next destination in Europe. End of our services. **(B)**
