You will begin in the capital, **Oslo**, a city that blends contemporary architecture with Viking history. From there, the journey takes you deep into **Norway's** mountainous heart as you ride one of the world's most spectacular train routes—first to **Myrdal**, then aboard the legendary **Flåm Railway**, descending into fjord country. You will cruise through the iconic **Aurlandsfjord** and the UNESCO-listed **Nærøfjord**, experiencing the landscapes that made Norway famous: steep cliffs, serene waters, tiny mountain farms, and scenery that feels untouched by time. In **Bergen**, you will discover a coastal city rich with merchant history, mountain views, and charming neighborhoods. Continuing along the **West Coast**, you will travel to **Stavanger**, home to beautifully preserved wooden houses and atmospheric streets. Then, following the southern railway line, you will reach **Kristiansand**, a lively summer port city known for its relaxed coastal lifestyle.

For travelers seeking a trip that is well-organized, diverse, scenic, and full of highlights, this itinerary offers everything: big cities, small villages, majestic landscapes, smooth logistics, and unforgettable moments—without stress, without complicated planning, and with the quality and care of our expert local team. #### DAY 1 ARRIVAL IN OSLO

Welcome to Oslo, a city where modern Scandinavian elegance meets Viking heritage and deep-forest serenity. Upon arrival at Oslo Airport, you will be greeted warmly by our local representative and escorted comfortably to your hotel. This afternoon, the Norwegian capital opens its heart to you. Our panoramic tour reveals the city's most enchanting corners—beginning at its vibrant center and continuing toward the monumental Vigeland Park, where more than 200 expressive statues form an open-air poetry of human life. From there, we ascend to the iconic Holmenkollen Ski Jump, standing proudly over the city like a sentinel of past winter triumphs. You will admire the medieval Akershus Fortress, gaze toward the shimmering fjord from the striking modern Oslo Opera House, and step into the worlds of ancient seafarers at the Viking Ship Museum. The tour concludes before the robust brick towers of Oslo City Hall, home of the Nobel Peace Prize ceremony. Overnight. **(B)**

#### DAY 2 OSLO – MYRDAL - FLAM

After breakfast, your adventure turns inland as you board the train at Oslo Central Station for a scenic five-hour journey through Norway's changing landscapes. Meadows melt into forested slopes, which rise slowly into high mountain wilderness. In Myrdal, you transfer to the legendary Flåm Railway, one of the steepest normal-gauge railways in the world. breathtaking descent from 900 meters above sea level feels like entering a living postcard—thundering waterfalls crash beside the tracks, emerald valleys open beneath you, and tiny mountain farms cling to impossible ledges. Soon, the valley widens, revealing Flåm, nestled like a jewel at the end of a branch of the mighty Sognefjord. Overnight in Flåm. **(B)**

**DAY 3 04 August FLAM – GUDHAVEN – VOSS – BERGEN**

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning in Flåm is a gentle awakening. Mists drift across the water, mountains glow with soft Nordic light, and time seems to move slower. In the morning, enjoy free hours to explore the area: wander along fjord pathways, rent a bicycle, or glide silently across the mirror-like water in a kayak. In the afternoon, a ferry carries you across the crystal waters of Aurlandsfjord and into the mystical Nærøyfjord, the narrowest fjord passage in all Europe. With cliffs rising almost vertically above you, the sense of awe is irresistible. Arriving in Gudvangen, you continue by bus through the dramatic Nærøy valley and ascend the thrilling Stalheimskeiva, famous for its series of 13 steep bends and extraordinary views. During the final stretch, you board a train from Voss toward Bergen, Norway's second-largest city.

Encircled by seven mountains and seven fjords, Bergen welcomes you with coastal charm and centuries of Hanseatic history. As night descends, a local aurora expert may take you to a semi-remote place to search the skies for the shimmering magic of the Northern Lights—one of Earth's most moving natural wonders. Overnight in central Bergen. **(B)**

**DAY 4 Saturday 05 August BERGEN – WEST COAST – STAVANGER Ferry Transfer**

After breakfast, you embark on a beautiful ferry journey southward along Norway's rugged west coast. The sea route unveils countless small islands, colorful fishing settlements, and lighthouses standing guard over the waves. Upon arriving in Stavanger, the charm of one of Norway's most atmospheric towns greets you instantly. Wander through its cobbled alleys, discover lively harbor markets, and admire the elegant wooden houses of Gamle Stavanger, one of Europe's best-preserved historical wooden districts. Evening at leisure. Accommodation in Stavanger. **(B)**

**DAY 5 Sunday 06 August STAVANGER - KRISTIANSAND Train cruise**

After breakfast, you board a comfortable train that follows Norway's scenic southern line. The coastline rolls by in waves of pine forest, beaches, quiet inlets, and seaside villages before arriving in Kristiansand, the "summer capital" of Norway. Kristiansand's old quarters, lively harbor, and sun-drenched cafés make it an irresistible place to stroll. Enjoy the rest of the day at your own pace—relax with a seaside walk, explore boutiques, or simply savor the festive summer atmosphere that fills the streets. Overnight in Kristiansand. **(B)**

**DAY 6 Monday 07 August KRISTIANSAND –OSLO**

Breakfast at the hotel. Your journey comes full circle today as you travel again along the Southern Line back to Oslo, watching Norway's varied landscape pass gracefully outside your window. Upon arrival, you have free time to enjoy the capital once more—perhaps savoring a waterfront meal, visiting a museum, or strolling through its green parks and elegant boulevards. Overnight in Oslo. **(B)**

**DAY 7 Tuesday 08 August OSLO AIRPORT – RETURN HOME**

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy your final Norwegian breakfast before your scheduled transfer to Oslo Airport. As you board your flight—with memories of fjords, mountains, and Northern Lights glowing within you—we thank you for traveling with us and wish you a safe journey home. End of our services. **(B)**
