The highlight of the trip will be however a few days in Buzios. Originally settled by European pirates and slave traders, this happy mixture of many bloods prospered and Buzios became a picturesque fishing village, elected one of the 10 most beautiful areas in the world, because of its rustic architecture, charm and incredible beauty with elegant restaurants and boutiques. Buzios became popular in the 1960's when it was visited by French actress Brigitte Bardot whose bronze statue can be found along the oceanfront.

Bahia is a State full of fishing villages and great beaches, one of the reasons why there are so many tourists coming to this region. It has also so much history related to old 16th Century forts, fish markets with fresh fish catch of the day. After the visits, you can relax at the hotel, swimming or perhaps playing beach volley. And for dinner, seafood is the first choice.

The most famous beaches are in Rio. Copacabana and Ipanema are the world best known areas with beautiful beach promenades and white sand. One of the pleasures on travelling is to get mixed with local people, and in case of Rio, with wonderful people, "gente maravilhosa" would say the cariocas (locals from Rio).

DAY 1 SALVADOR DE BAHIA

Upon arrival of your scheduled international flight to Salvador de Bahia, reception at the airport by our cooperation partner and drive to the hotel for registration. Salvador is one of the 10 largest cities in Brazil. The historical name of the coastal town is São Salvador da Bahia de Todos os Santos (Holy Saviour of the Bay of All Saints), as it is situated on the Bay of All Saints. Salvador has about 2.7 million inhabitants and is the capital of the northeastern state of Bahia. Until 1763 was the capital of Brazil. Site of Salvador's Archbishop (Archdiocese of São Salvador da Bahia), has two universities, a cocoa Institute, a zoological and a botanical garden. Salvador is built on different levels, a range of mountains, which divide the city into an upper city (Cidade Alta) and 70 meters below, a Lower City (Cidade Baixa). After registration, free time to recover from your flight. In the afternoon, historical tour of Salvador. Back to the hotel. Overnight.

DAY 2 SALVADOR - MORRO DE SAO PAULO

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to the port for a two-and-half-hour boat ride to Morro de Sao Paulo, a place located on the island of Ilha de Tinharé, in the municipality of Cairu, in the state of Bahia. The region is also known as the Costa do Dendê, because the Dende oil is extracted from the oil palm. Today the place is a hot tip for the Brazilian tourism since the island's beaches are considered as very beautiful. The town of Morro de São Paulo has its own tourist infrastructure with many inns and restaurants. The island is accessible by ferry. Throughout the island is prohibited - similarly to Helgoland in Germany and many other islands- any type of motor vehicle traffic. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. **(B)**

DAY 3 MORRO DE SAO PAULO

Breakfast at hotel. The whole day is at leisure. You can enjoy the beautiful beaches of the island. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 4 MORRO DE SAO PAULO - SALVADOR - FORTALEZA

Breakfast at the hotel. Boat transfer to the mainland in Salvador and then bus transfer to the airport for your flight to Fortaleza, the capital of the state of Ceará. Upon arrival transfer to the hotel in Fortaleza. Brazil's northeast, above all Fortaleza, has developed into a tourist center. With a 573 km long coastline, well equipped, beautiful beaches, tropical climate and a variety of attractions, Fortaleza has about various natural and cultural attractions. Fortaleza is popular because of the usually sunny weather. The region is also known as "Terra do Sol" (Land of the Sun). Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 5 FORTALEZA - JERICOACOARA

After breakfast, drive from Fortaleza to Jericoacoara, the center of a vast dune area in northeastern Brazil. The dunes extend up to 20 km inland. Jericoacoara was officially declared a national park in 2002. A special attraction are sweet water lakes lying between the dunes. Among windsurfers and kites, Jericoacoara is one of the best destinations in the world. The ride in the 4x4 will take about 5 to 6 hours and upon arrival, we drive to the hotel. Overnight **(B)**

DAY 6 JERICOACOARA

Breakfast at the hotel. The whole day is at leisure. You can enjoy the beautiful beaches of the area or practice your favourite sports (windsurfing, kite surfing, kayaks, buggy ride, sand boarding, horse riding, etc -optional services-). Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 7 JERICOACOARA – FORTALEZA - RIO DE JANEIRO

After breakfast, early transfer to the airport for your flight to Rio. Arrival in Rio de Janeiro airport. Reception and transfer to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 8 RIO DE JANEIRO

Breakfast at the hotel. Full day excursion in Rio. Our first destination is the statue of Christ, which was recently chosen as one of the seven modern wonders of the world. The statue is located 697 m. above sea level, atop Corcovado Hill. After a scenic drive along the Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon, we will arrive at the foot of the hill where we climb the beautiful mountain on a small train. Once on top, you will experience and discover a panoramic view of Rio de Janeiro and learn why it is called the "Cidade Maravilhosa" "marvelous city"! Little break for lunch at a barbecue restaurant. Afternoon trip to Sugar Loaf - More than a million tourists visit every year the world famous Pão de Acucar (Sugar Loaf), which has an iconic symbol of the city of Rio de Janeiro. The Sugar Loaf is located on a small peninsula at the entrance of Guanabara Bay. He carries his name because its shape is reminiscent of a sugar loaf. The first cable car takes passengers to the top of Urca Hill, which rises 215 meters above sea level and offers spectacular views over the bay and its islands. From Urca Hill, we will continue going up in a second cable car to the summit of Sugar Loaf Mountain, which rises 395 meters above sea level and offers a 360-degree view of the entire city including Botafogo and Copacabana beaches, Corcovado and downtown Rio. Back at the hotel. Overnight **(B) (L)**

DAY 9 RIO DE JANEIRO - BÚZIOS

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, we drive to Búzios in private service with tour guide. Búzios is known, since the "discovery" by Brigitte Bardot and Jacques Cousteau in 1964, formerly a sleepy fishing village, as "The pearl of the Costa do Sol" (Sun Coast), 170 km east of Rio de Janeiro. Tourism has become the most important economic sector before fishing. In Brazil had only Foz do Iguaçu and five million-cities (Rio de Janeiro, Sao Paulo, Salvador, Recife and Brasilia) more foreigners' nights as the little Búzios. Among Brazilians Búzios is consider elitist. The center is located on a 16-acre, hilly peninsula. Around the peninsula are 25 beach coves, which are among the most beautiful in Brazil. Overnight stay in a pousada **(B)**

DAY 10 BÚZIOS

Breakfast at hotel. The whole day is at leisure. You can enjoy the beautiful beaches of the area. Overnight at Pousada **(B)**
