In order to avoid a trip of 5 days (2.5 days to go there and 2.5 to return) through the stormy waters of the Drake sea. From here, you will travel for 6 days and 5 nights and visit the most beautiful places and the greatest concentration of fauna in this bright continent. In addition, you will be able to explore the beautiful city of Santiago and the southernmost city in Chile, Punta Arenas.

DAY 1 ARRIVAL IN SANTIAGO

Reception at the airport by our cooperation partner and drive to the hotel. Afternoon sightseeing tour of the city. We drive past the Club Hípico, along the Parque O'Higgins and the Palacio Cousiño, a magnificent City Palace, built between 1870 and 1878. We come into the city center. On the way, you see the government palace La Moneda, the Universidad de Chile, the Church of San Francisco, the National Library and the Santa Lucia mountains where Santiago was founded on 1541. It continues along the Alameda. We cross the Río Mapocho. By the artist and nightlife Bella Vista Drive to the city hill Cerro San Cristobal. From here, you have a wonderful view over Santiago. On the way back to the hotel, you will see the modern residential Vitacura and Las Condes. **(B) (L)**

DAY 2 SANTIAGO - VALPARAISO - VIÑA DEL MAR

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure towards the coast of Chile. On the way, it is possible to see the changing scenery and vegetation of Curacaví and Casablanca valleys and the Cordillera de la Costa (Coastal Mountain Range). Arrival in Valparaíso, the main commercial port of Chile. There you will see the colorful houses built on the hill. The excursion will continue along the coast of Valparaíso to Vina del Mar, known as the "Ciudad Jardín" (Garden City). Worth seeing are the floral clock, the Wulff Castle, the Municipal Casino, the Peru Avenue, Acapulco beach and Muelle Vergara (Vergara Pier). We continue along the coast through the beaches of Las Salinas, Reñaca and Cochoa. Back to Santiago **(B)**

DAY 3 SANTIAGO

Breakfast at hotel. The day is at leisure. We recommend you to visit one of the nearby wineries of Santiago, including wine tasting. **(B)**

DAY 4 SANTIAGO - PUNTA ARENAS

Breakfast at the hotel. Early transfer to the airport for your flight to Punta Arenas. Arrival in Punta Arenas where you will be welcome by the Antarctica XXI crew. Transfer to the hotel. In the afternoon, before dinner, you will have a mandatory briefing regarding the rules that are followed in Antarctica, in and out procedures. Later we will enjoy a welcome dinner of typical Chilean food where you will meet your partner for this expedition. Accommodation Hotel Rey Don Felipe. **(B) (D)**

DAY 5 PUNTA ARENAS - ANTARCTIC ISLA JORGE REY ABOARD ANTARTICA XXI

Transfer to Punta Arenas airport for your flight to Isla Rey Jorge, King George Island (South Shetlands) with a scheduled two-hour flight. Upon landing the clear Antarctic air will fill your lungs. You then walk 2-km (1.25-mi), passing Chile's Frei Station and Russia's Bellingshausen Station, to reach the shore and board a Zodiac that will take you to your boutique expedition vessel. **(B) (L) (D)**

DAY 6 - DAY 9 ISLA AITCHO - DECEPTION ISLAND - PUNTA ANA - PUERTO LOCKROY - PETERMANN ISLAND - CUVERVILLE ICELAND

During these days, we will be sailing between the South Shetland Islands and the western coast of the Antarctic Peninsula, sailing along ice-filled fjords and among spectacular icebergs, while enjoying the company of seabirds, penguins, seals, and whales. Each day disembark by Zodiac and explore the landscape together with expert polar guides. On board the ship, attend an engaging program of educational presentations, and enjoy spectacular views from the lounge while sharing your daily adventures with fellow guests. No journey is the same and flexibility is the key to success in Antarctica. The Expedition Team plans the voyage route to take advantage of the ever-changing opportunities provided by nature, crafting a unique and extraordinary experience every time. While the exact itinerary changes with each expedition, you will explore several sites that offer the best possible overview of the varied Antarctic environment. Your voyage may include visits to sites in the South Shetland Islands, the Antarctic Sound, the Gerlache Strait, and the Penola Strait. **(B) (L)(D)**

DAY 10 FREI STATION - PUNTA ARENAS

Breakfast on board. Return to King George Island and bid farewell to Antarctica before boarding your flight back to Punta Arenas. Upon arrival from the 7th continent, transfer to your hotel for the night and enjoy an evening at your own leisure. **(B)**

DAY 11 PUNTA ARENAS - SANTIAGO

Today, your air-cruise officially ends. After breakfast transfer to the airport for your flight to Santiago. Reception by our partners and transfer to the hotel. The day is at leisure. **(B)**

DAY 12 SANTIAGO - AIRPORT

Breakfast at hotel. The day is free for private matters. You can relax in the hotel or realize the last shopping. Early transfer to the airport for your flight back home. **(B)**

How do I prepare my trip to Antarctica?

Traveling to Antarctica also means planning your travel way ahead of time. International flights, visas, travel insurance – it's all part of the planning process. You will need clothing similar to ski gear and to think about how to pack light. As you are taking an air-cruise the weight limit for baggage (including hand luggage) is 20 kg (44 Lb.). During the austral summer, the Antarctic Peninsula's average temperature, where most Antarctica cruises sail, is about 0° C (32° F). But it may feel lower because of the wind chill factor.
