When you arrive in Sintra, enjoy some free time to wander around and discover the town's historic centre, exploring the narrow streets and sampling the famous "queijadas and travesseiros". Visit to the Pena Palace (entrance and guided tour), the most complete example of Romantic architecture in Portugal. Lunch by the beach beforewe return to Lisbon. Dinner experience in a "Fado" house restaurant. Overnight at the selected hotel in Lisbon. (B) (L) (D).

DAY 3 Sunday, May 12 NAZARE – BATALHA - FATIMA

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check-out and departure to Nazaré. We journey onward to Nazaré, a picturesque fishing village, where we recommend a pause for lunch (optional and free) to savor the freshly caught fish while basking in the splendid ocean vista. Take the opportunity to visit the Sanctuary and the Chapel of Remembrance, soaking in the serene ambiance of this coastal gem. Continuing our voyage, we proceed towards our ultimate destination, Lisbon. of Batalha lies the most significant collection of Portuguese medieval stained-glass windows, prominently showcased in the Main Chapel and the Chapter House. We then venture to the Religious Centre of Portugal - Fátima - to delve deeper into the phenomenon of the Apparitions of Fátima, which unfolded on May 13th, 1917. Our pilgrimage commences with a visit to the Sanctuary, followed by explorations of the Basilica and the Chapel of the Apparitions, offering profound insights into this historic event. Check in at the selected hotel, dinner and overnight. **(B) (D)**

DAY 4 Monday, May 13 FATIMA - AVEIRO - COIMBRA

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check-out and departure to Aveiro. We will travel through the center of Portugal, characterized by its diversity. DAY 5 Tuesday, May 14 COIMBRA - PORTO

Breakfast at the Hotel. Check-out and departure to Porto. Full day guided tour of Porto, the capital of northern Portugal and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Everything about this marvellous city makes this tour a memorable journey, from the Cathedral to the Port Wine Cellars, where you can enjoy a tasting of two wines. You'll also have the opportunity to discover the Portuguese tradition and culture and will be given important references about the streets and squares of the historic centre. Dinner at the selected hotel in Porto. (B) (D) DAY 6 Wednesday, May 15 PORTO – DOURO - PORTO

Following this, immerse yourself in the rich heritage of the region at the Alcobaça Wine Museum, offering a unique opportunity for wine enthusiasts to discover the history, traditions, and production methods of local wines. Afterward, relish in leisure time to indulge in a delightful lunch of your choice (optional). The medieval charm of Óbidos awaits, beckoning with its picturesque streets and well-preserved architecture. Founded in 1195, Óbidos stands as one of Portugal's finest medieval villages, adorned with whitewashed, blue, and yellow houses adorned with vibrant flowers. At the pinnacle of this charming historic town lies the imposing Óbidos Castle, a testament to its rich heritage dating back to the 14th century. Return to Lisbon and overnight in Lisbon. **(B) (D)**
