DAY 1 (Saturday, June 22) ARRIVAL IN GERMANY

Continue walking to the Opera House, inaugurated in 1880 in a stunning neoclassical architectural style. See also the Opernplatz, a square surrounded by elegant buildings and green spaces. Next is the Financial district with a yuxtaposition of historic architecture and modern skyscrapers to end the tour in the shopping mile where you will find upscale shops and boutiques. Back to the hotel and time at leisure. Overnight at the Holiday Inn Alter Oper or similar.

DAY 2 (Sunday, June 23) FRANKFURT - RHINE VALLEY - FRANKFURT

Breakfast at the hotel. The itinerary unfolds like a story, with the Rhine River becoming the setting for an unforgettable chapter. tour to the city of Potsdam, the capital of the State of Brandenburg, south from Berlin Center. Potsdam has several claims to national and international notability. In Germany, it had the status Windsor has in Britain because it was residence of Prussian kings and German Kaisers, until 1918. Considered to be one of the most beautiful areas just outside of Berlin, no visit to the city would be complete without experiencing this unique gem. Royal palaces dot the tranguil landscape of a town whose prominent role in modern history would be hard to overstate. Sights you will visit with us include Sansscouci Palace with it's enchanting landscaped gardens, the Neues Palais from where the last German Kaiser abdicated at the end of WWI, and Cecelienhof which was the location for the aforementioned Potsdam Conference. Time permitting, we also take a drive through the freshly renovated Altstadt, as well as over the Glienicke bridge, witness to many of the famous spy swaps of the Cold War. After visiting the park, return to Berlin. Free time for private activities. Overnight at the art'otel Berlin Mitte 4*** or similar. (B)

DAY 4 (Tuesday, June 25) BERLIN

Breakfast at the hotel. Today sees you traversing Berlin's streets on a morning city tour, uncovering the tales of the Berlin Wall Park. You will see the highlights of the city and hear original soundtracks of speeches by Kennedy, Reagan and Hitler at those exact locations where they spoke: Pre-World War II (Brandenburg Gate, Victory Column, Berliner Cathedral, Museum Island, Reichstag, St. Nikolai Quarter, Kurfürstendamm, Gedächtniskirche Rotes Rathaus ...); Nazi Sights (Hitler's Bunker and Chancellery, Soviet War Memorial, Jewish Holocaust Memorial....); Cold War Sights (The Wall, Checkpoint Charlie, TV Tower, Alexanderplatz, Berlin Philharmonic....) and finally Post Cold War Sights (Pariser Platz, Chancellor's Office, Hotel Adlon, Potsdamer Platz). After the city tour time to rest, shopping or discover another interesting point in the city. As the sun sets, the stadium beckons for the Netherlands vs. Austria match, a clash that promises skillful play and fierce competition. After the match, transfer to your hotel. Overnight at the art'otel Berlin Mitte 4**** or similar. (B)

DAY 5 (Wednesday, June 26) BERLIN

Breakfast at the hotel. Today Berlin unfolds at your pace. Visit the iconic Reichstag, a must for its historical significance, architectural brilliance, and the opportunity to ascend its iconic glass dome. The Reichstag is a symbol of Germany's democracy, housing the Bundestag (Parliament). The dome offers panoramic views of Berlin, and the building's history, coupled with its modern design, makes it a compelling destination for both cultural and architectural enthusiasts. Also, marvel at the treasures within museums with the Berlin Museuminsel Pass. You will have a seamless access to the UNESCO-listed Museum Island's five world-class museums, including the Pergamon Museum and the Neues Museum. If you prefer an optional tour we can recommend to visit Sachsenhausen Nazi Concentration Camp. This tour provides a poignant and educational experience, offering insight into the dark history of the Nazi era. The concentration camp's preserved grounds serve as a powerful reminder of the atrocities committed during World War II, fostering awareness, reflection, and a commitment to preserving historical memory. Overnight at the art'otel Berlin Mitte 4**** or similar. (B)

DAY 6 (Thursday, June 27) BERLIN

Breakfast at the Hotel. Bid farewell to Berlin with a smooth transfer to Berlin Airport, marking the end of your football-infused adventure in Germany.
