Here in the Atacama Desert, we offer you a trip based on accommodation, which is considered the central point to explore the natural and cultural environment of the region.*

*From the arrival in Santiago de Chile, luxury hotels will be waiting for you to live this experience with all the ingredients you expect. We will also have a unique experience in the Vineyard of Concha y Toro before boarding the plane that will take us to Calama. Once at the hotel we propose (we can look for some others since to date many other luxury hotels have been opened). Although the program will be able to - in this case - vary a little, visits will be concentrated in the desert without losing a single detail, among others, the moon valley, the highland lagoons and the Los Flamings National Reserve.*

*In Bolivia we will also live an adventure outside the reality, especially when we arrive at our salt hotel, a building built entirely with blocks of salt. There awaits us the Salar de Uyuni with all its splendor. You will also have the experience to sleep in the first dome placed at the shores of Laguna Hedionda, close to the Avaroa National Park, with coloured lagunes, and fumaroles. To return to Santiago, we will take a different and unknown path that will take us back to the sea and Calama for our flight back to Santiago and home, with a cluster of experiences that you will never forget. ### **DAY 1 (Friday) ARRIVAL IN SANTIAGO**

International flight to Santiago de Chile. Reception at Santiago airport and transfer to the Hotel. Registration. In the afternoon visit to the city of Santiago, starting at Cerro Santa Lucia, where the city was founded in 1541. We will continue towards The San Cristobal Hill. Then we will visit the Plaza de Armas (main square) with the "La Moneda" Government Palace and other important national monuments such as the Cathedral, Central Post Office (main post office) and the Municipality of Santiago (City Hall). The unit continues across the Mapocho River and through several residential areas overlooking the city. Return to the hotel in Santiago. Dinner and accommodation. **(L) (D)**

### **DAY 2 (Saturday) SANTIAGO - VIÑA CONCHA Y TORO - SANTIAGO**

Departure from Santiago to the south. Arrival in Pique, where you will find the vineyard "Concha y Toro", the largest wine producer in Chile. Tour of the "Patronal House" (mansion) with the beautiful park and the lagoon. Access to vineyards and deposits of these internationally renowned wines. Visit the wineries, including the famous "Casillero del Diablo", taking into account its production. There is a wine shop at the end. The tour continues along the Maipo River, with lunch on the way, through the residential area of Las Vertientes, where you will see typical cabins, camps, restaurants and cottages. Return to the hotel in Santiago. Dinner & Accommodation **(B) (L) (D)**

### **DAY 3 (Sunday) SANTIAGO - CALAMA -SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA**

Early airport transfer for your flight to Calama. Reception at the airport and transfer to San Pedro de Atacama. During the trip, it is possible to see the Cordillera de la Sal (Salt Range) and the Licancábur volcano. Arrival in San Pedro de Atacama and check-in at the selected hotel. Lunch. Afternoon off. Dinner and accommodation **(B) (L) (D)**

### **DAY 4 (Monday) SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA - VALLEY OF THE MOON – SAN PEDRO**

Breakfast. Choose one of the excursions available at Larache Hotel. On foot, by bike, on horseback, half-day or full-day excursions, light or moderate. These excursions allow you to acclimatize to the maximum to the height, preparing to face the trip to the Bolivian Highlands. In addition, they will reveal the complex geography of Atacama, its fauna and ancient culture. In the afternoon, excursion to the valley of the moon, known for its salt caves, for its rock formation called "three Marys" and for its great dune. From this point you will experience a beautiful sunset. Return to the hotel and accommodation. **(B) (L) (D)**

### **DAY 5 (Tuesday) SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA - ALTIPLANICA LAGUNAS - SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA**

Full-day tour with visit to the village of Toconao with its interesting rhyolite stone factories. We continue our journey to the Salinas de Atacama, the location of the Los Flamingos National Reserve and where the three most beautiful species of flamingos live. We will continue towards the plateau of the Miscanti and Miñiques lagoons more than 4000 meters above sea level. Return to the hotel in San Pedro de Atacama. Accommodation. **(B) (L) (D)**

### **DAY 6 (Wednesday) SAN PEDRO**

Breakfast at the hotel. The day is available for private activities. You can enjoy hotel facilities, horseback riding or cycling (or both), walk around and much more. The hotel concierge will help you define your day trips. Lunch and dinner at the hotel. We'll spend the night at the selected Hotel. **(B) (L) (D)**

### **DAY 7 (Thursday) SAN PEDRO – LAGUNAS DE COLORES- LOS FLAMENCOS (BOLIVIA)**

Early departure from the hotel. Crossing to Bolivia through the Hito Cajón border point, in the southeastern part of the country, passing through the volcanic mountain range where the Licancabur volcano is located. We will enter the Eduardo Avaroa Reserve, visiting Laguna Verde, the deserts of the Chalviri lagoon and its hot springs of Polques, geysers, Sol de Mañana and Laguna Colorada, Andean flamingos. Visit the stone tree, lagoons of Ramaditas, Honda, Chiacota, Laguna Hedionda. We will spend the night in a dome at the Los Flamencos Eco-hotel. **(B) (L) (D)**

### **DAY 8 (Friday) ALTIPLANO BOLIVIANO: LOS FLAMENCOS – UYUNI – COLCHANI -E-bike-Tour: 45 km**

After breakfast, walk through the area, and then we will continue our journey in the Bolivian highlands, with heights between 4300 and 3600 m. above sea level. Crossing of the ancient mining and two hours of trekking that surround the lake, inhabited by a great endemic fauna. Continue to visit the Cañapa lagoon, the Ollague volcano Viewpoint, the San Juan mummies, the entrance to the salt flat and along the way we will visit Incahuasi Island, which is a natural habitat of giant cacti. Here we will start pedaling the salt flats with modern electric bikes (E-bikes). Free trip in the salt flat with endless roads and spectacular views of the world's largest salt platform until you reach Colchani. Check-in at the Palacio de Sal Hotel built entirely with salt blocks. Even chairs and beds are made of these blocks. Dinner and accommodation. **(B) (L) (D)**

### **DAY 9 (Saturday) BOLIVIAN ALTIPLANO: COLCHANI - PULACAYO – COQUESA (E-bike-Tour: 53 km)**

After breakfast, we will visit the island of Sajchilla with ancient cacti, an unexplored place. We continue towards Coquesa at the foot of Thunupa volcano. Accommodation at Tambo Coquesa Lodge. After a short break, visit the Chantani Mummies Museum and stone shapes. At the end of the afternoon, we find the ideal place to watch the







sunset, accompanied by a coca cocktail as a welcome drink. Return to the hotel, dinner and accommodation. **(B) (L) (D)**

**DAY 10 (Sunday) BOLIVIAN ALTIPLANO: COQUESA – JIRIRA (Trekking Tour)**

Early in the morning, a three- or four-hour trek to the foothills of the Tunupa volcano begins, at its 5432 meters high. At this point, you will visit several interesting places in the surrounding area. You may also decide to climb the volcano to enjoy the view from its highest point, which requires more time. Return to the hotel for lunch. Free time in the afternoon. At sunset, we will visit small villages located next to the platform: Tahua, Coquesa and Jirira. Return to dinner and accommodation at Tambo Coquesa Ecolodge. **(B) (L) (D)**

**DAY 11 (Monday) BOLIVIAN ALTIPLANO - CHILEAN ALTIPLANO**

Early departure to the border with Chile, crossing the city of Llica, with a short stop. At lunch, a picnic will be held at the Estancia Irpa, next to the Salar de Coipasa, at 3600 m.a.s.l. Then, the journey continues to Piriga, at the Bolivian border crossing, reaching beyond Colchane, on the Chilean side. We border the Isluga River, where we will find a wetland with a great fauna. During the night, arrive in Aravilla, in the Isluga National Park, where you will find a camp for the night, 4020 m. above sea level. **(B) (L) (D)**

**DAY 12 (Tuesday) CHILEAN ALTIPLANO - IQUIQUE**

In the morning, a trekking will take place in the wetlands. We will walk along a hill located in the vicinity of the small village of Mauque, where we will find some remains of ritual stone constructions. A picnic will be prepared there. The descent starts from the plateau to Iquique, a Chilean port in the Pacific Ocean, which descends from 4000 meters to sea level. Use your free time to enjoy the beaches of Iquique. At the end of the day, dinner in the city and accommodation in the hotel. **(B) (L) (D)**

**DAY 13 (Wednesday) IQUIQUE - SANTIAGO**

During the morning, transfer to the airport for your connecting flight to Santiago. Arrival in Santiago and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day off for personal activities. **(B) (L) (D)**

**DAY 14 (Thursday) SANTIAGO - AIRPORT**

Breakfast at the hotel. At the indicated time, departure to the airport for your international flight back home or connections to other destinations in South America. End of our services **(B)**
