Then, witness the grandeur of **Iguazu Falls** from both Argentina and Brazil—an awe-inspiring spectacle of raw beauty and thundering energy. Brazil will greet you with its unmistakable vibrancy: the pulsating beats of Carnival, the breathtaking views from Corcovado and Sugar Loaf, and the warm hospitality that defines **Rio**. Taste the richness of local flavors, wander through cultural gems, and unwind in the coastal paradise of **Paraty**, where colonial history meets the serenity of the sea. Every day on this itinerary offers unforgettable experiences, carefully curated to reflect the heart of two iconic nations. Whether you're drawn to nature, cuisine, music, or heritage, this journey promises moments that will stay with you long after your return. Let the adventure begin.

DAY 1 ARRIVAL IN BUENOS AIRES

Upon arrival of your scheduled international flight to Buenos Aires, the capital of Argentina, reception at the airport by our cooperation partner and drive to the hotel for registration. Situated on Argentina's stunning Rio de la Plata coast, Buenos Aires is a thriving portside capital defined by a rich history, vibrant culture, and strong European influence - thus nicknamed the Paris of South America. After a short break to rejuvenate from the long haul flight, we will pick you up and take you for lunch before we start the approx. 6-hour city tour. Begin at the iconic Plaza de Mayo, explore the historic neighborhoods of San Telmo and La Boca, and experience the modern elegance of Puerto Madero. Delve into cultural landmarks such as the Colón Teather, the Recoleta neighborhood, and El Ateneo Grand Splendid (one of the most beautiful bookstores in the world). Marvel at the incredible engineering feat of the Floralis Genérica and the brilliant academic environment of the University of Buenos Aires Law School. Back to the hotel. Overnight at the NH Buenos Aires 9 de Julio Hotel or similar. **(L)**

DAY 2 BUENOS AIRES Tigre & Delta

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you will have a private full day excursion to the Delta del Tigre, located on the northwestern edge of the metropolitan area of the capital Buenos Aires. The name is based on a misunderstanding: Tigers have never lived in Argentina, but jaguars. These were mistakenly thought to be tigers, giving the city and Delta their name. Tigre is bordered directly by the delta of the Parana River, which flows into the Rio de la Plata about ten km. from the city. This has made Tigre a popular recreation area for the inhabitants of Buenos Aires. The islands of the delta are full of clubs, sports facilities and restaurants. Back to the hotel. In the evening, dinner Tango Show at "La Ventana", a fully restored historic tenement house in Buenos Aires. The interiors, which preserve the purest of the building, are the ideal environment for a unique proposal with 32 artists on stage: two Tango orchestras, a folk music group, dancers and singers. Dinner includes international cuisine with a wide variety of starters, main courses,

DAY 3 BUENOS AIRES - FOZ DE IGUAZU Argentinian side of the Falls

Breakfast at the hotel. Early transfer to the airport for your flight to Iguazu Falls. Reception at the airport by our cooperation partners and to the hotel on the Brazilian side of the falls. At a given time, your guide will pick you up and take you for lunch in a local restaurant. Then, you will start your adventure at the falls on the Argentine side. While mainly on the Brazilian side you can enjoy the panoramic view of the waterfalls, you can hike on the Argentinian side very close between isolated waterfalls. Included in the New Seven Wonders of Nature list, the wonderful Iguazu Falls are located in the border that divides Brazil, Argentine and Paraguay, what gives guests the opportunity to admire the natural show in different angles. Many observation decks, suspended walkaways and transport modes are disposed to provide the best experiences. It is incredible to appreciate the immensity and strength of the water that falls uninterruptedly. The Argentinean side has two thirds of the falls of Iguassu Falls, what makes the visit exciting, as guests have the emotion of feeling the strength of the waterfalls very closely. There are trails and two circuits around the park, so guests can admire the natural phenomenon from different points of view. One of the most incredible experiences is to go to Devil's Throat, where is possible to see the strong waterfall from the top. To get to the catwalks and see the Falls, guests take the gas-propelled train that will lead to the Upper Falls Circuits, for walks around forests and beautiful landscapes, and especially the Devil's Throat, which provides one of the best views of the Falls, due to the impact of the water that makes big clouds of steam and form an incredible rainbow. After the visit, we drive back to the hotel. Overnight at the Vivaz Cataratas Hotel Resort or similar. (B) (L)

DAY 4 FOZ DE IGUAZU Brazilian side of the Falls and Bord Park

Breakfast at the hotel. Today we visit the Brazilian side of the falls and the bird Park. Beautiful panoramic views offer the best impression on the overall extent of this unique natural spectacle. The Birds Park is one of the most known attractions of the region, as it is the habitat of birds from all over the world. In beautiful scenery, guests have a direct contact with more than 1020 birds of 150 different species preserved in 16.5 hectares of the spectacular Atlantic Forest. There is also three great aviaries and a butterfly house, in which guests can enter and be side by side with toucans, scarlet ibises, macaws, jays and thrushes. There is so much to see, learn and appreciate. Seeing macaws' colorful wings and looking closely to the birds' eyes make this experience unique. Lunch at local restaurant. Back to the hotel. Overnight. (B) (L) DAY 5 IGUAZU - RIO DE JANEIRO Roxy Dinner Show

Breakfast at hotel. Check-out time and transfer to IGU airport. Arrival at Rio airport (GIG), reception by your local guide and transfer to the hotel. You will have free time to relax and enjoy the beaches in Rio. At the evening, we will take you out for dinner. The Roxy Dinner Show, located in the heart of Copacabana, is a revitalized cultural icon that combines the elegance of Art Deco architecture with modern entertainment. This venue offers an immersive experience that blends exquisite Brazilian cuisine with captivating performances, celebrating the rich cultural diversity of Brazil. The show takes audiences on a journey through music, dance, and visual arts, making it a must-visit attraction for all visitors. Overnight at the hotel Windsor Leme or similar. (B) (D)

DAY 6 RIO DE JANEIRO Corcovado

Breakfast at hotel. Today we will offer you a tasting of tropical fruits at a local market on the way to Corcovado. Departure for the Corcovado Mountain which culminates at more than 700 m above the city. It is here that the Christ the Redeemer, a huge soapstone statue (30 m of statue, 8 m of base, 28 m of wingspan), built by the French sculptor Paul Landowski, was inaugurated in 1931. From here that opening its arms and symbolizing what characterizes, the traditions of welcome and hospitality of the Brazilian people. Lunch in a local restaurant and free time. Overnight (B) (L)

DAY 7 RIO DE JANEIRO Sugar Loaf

Breakfast at hotel. Today you will visit the Sugar Loaf. More than a million tourists each year visit the world famous Pão de Acucar (Sugar Loaf), which is an iconic symbol of the city of Rio de Janeiro. The Sugar Loaf is located on a small peninsula at the entrance of Guanabara Bay. It carries





the top of Urca Hill, which rises 215 meters above sa level and offers spectacular views over the bay and its islands. From Urca Hill, we will continue going up in a second cable car to the summit of the Sugarloaf Mountain, which rises 395 meters above sea level and offers a 360-degree view of the entire city including Botafogo and Copacabana beaches, Corcovado, and downtown Rio. Back to the city for lunch in a local restaurant. After lunch, we will offer you a Carnival Experience. One of the most famous Carnivals of the world is in Rio. This is the biggest Brazilian cultural manifestation and a democrat celebration, where everyone interact and have fun together regardless of their origin. This parade is a huge event that involves thousands of people that want to wear a custom and participate in a unique opportunity that provides a memorable experience. This is a tour behind the scenes of Carnival. In the complex of Samba City, where all samba schools have their creation warehouses, a guide explains about the history of samba, allegories and the Carnival parade in Rio de Janeiro. It goes around the warehouse with customs and parade items in progress and guests have the opportunity to try the costumes, feeling a little bit of the Carnival essence. After that exciting visit, they have time to taste the traditional caipirinha, a cocktail made with cachaça (sugar cane hard liquor), lemon and sugar, before heading back to the hotel. But before arriving at the hotel, stop at a kiosk on the beach to taste coconut water. In the evening, we will take you to Río Scenarium (from wed to sat). Located in the heart of Rio de Janeiro in Brazil, Rio Scenarium is a popular nightspot offering a variety of pub fare and refreshing drinks, as well as live music performances and dancing. The establishment is spread out over three floors and decorated with antiques. There is a stage on the first floor that visitors can view from the balconies on the other floors. Entrance fee included, drinks are not. Overnight. (B) (L)

DAY 8 RIO DE JANEIRO - PARATY Walking tour

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, we drive to Paraty in private service with tour guide. On the Costa Verde, surrounded by quiet beaches and peninsulas, beguiling Paraty is known for its exceptional colonial architecture. The historical district is a joy to explore, with cobblestone streets winding between whitewashed buildings and baroque churches. Cultural offerings are not limited to the historical, however – Paraty is home to many creative souls and entrepreneurs from around the world, whose restaurants, galleries, and shops give the town a cosmopolitan feel. Nature lovers will enjoy the nearby reserves, parks, and mountains that surround this enticing destination. We will take you for lunch and then, you will have a walking visit with a local guide, including cachaça tasting during the visit. This lovely city has preserved its colonial architecture and natural beauty over the years. Along the charming streets, you will discover the historical center: the churches of Nossa Senhora dos Remedios, Santa Rita, Nossa Senhora do Rosário and Nossa Senhora das Dores, the House of Culture and the old buildings and monuments from the 18th century. Overnight stay at the Pousada do Principe 4**** or similar. (B) (L)

DAY 09 PARATY Schooner Cruise

Breakfast at hotel. Aboard a schooner, charming traditional boat, you will travel to two beautiful islands with exotic beaches. You can swim and relax in the sun (for 40 minutes on each site). The schooner has small boats to transport you directly on the sand, a bar, a restaurant, and commoditie on board. Lunch on board. Overnight at the Pousada (B) (L)

DAY 10 PARATY - RIO DE JANEIRO Departure

Breakfast at hotel. The day is at leisure until timely transfer to the airport for your flight home. End of our services **(B)**
