Visit two fantastic medieval cities, **Rothenburg ob der Taube** in Germany and **Bruges** in Belgium. Travel on to the capital cities of the **Netherlands** and **Belgium**, then soak in the romance of **Paris** with its storied streets, Eiffel Tower, and Seine River cruise. Continue south to **Lyon**, and finally revel in the beauty of the Côte d'Azur with **Saint-Tropez**, **Nice**, and **Monaco**. Live your cultural adventure with us.

DAY 1 FRANKFURT AIRPORT - FRANKFURT

Upon arrival at Frankfurt Airport, you will be met by our representative and transferred to your downtown hotel. Rest of the day at leisure to explore the city on your own. Stroll through the historic Römerberg Square with its picturesque timber-framed houses. Head toward the Main River, crossing one of its bridges for a spectacular view of the modern "Mainhattan" skyline. Return to the city center to see the Opera House and browse the bustling shopping mile. You'll also find plenty of excellent restaurants nearby. If you're looking for something special, don't hesitate to ask us for recommendations. Overnight in Frankfurt.

DAY 2 FRANKFURT Day trip to the fairy tale city of Rothenburg ob der Taube

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today we will offer you a day trip to Rothenburg, located on the Romantic Road high above the Tauber Valley, and considered one of the most beautiful medieval towns in Germany. Seeing Rothenburg ob der Tauber's forty-two gates and towers etched against the unspoiled countryside from a distance, you'd swear you were looking at the Fifteenth Century through field glasses. You can walk through the picturesque old streets with their half-timbered houses, to the city gates and the mighty Renaissance town hall, the beautiful castle garden and St. James' Church with the world-famous "Holy Blood Altar" by Tilman Riemenschneider. And on to a visit to the Crime Museum, the magical Doll and Toy Museum or the Christmas Museum. Rothenburg is an incredible journey through time. And a special place for beautiful souvenirs: wood carvings, glasses, Christmas decorations, beer mugs and even cuckoo clocks. Recommended in culinary terms: the "snowballs" made from sweet shortcrust pastry. Back to Frankfurt. Overnight.

DAY 3 FRANKFURT - COLOGNE

Departure after breakfast towards Cologne, a city known for its Gothic cathedral. Go to the train station at the scheduled time. At arrival, a vehicle will be waiting for you and will take

you to the hotel. After registering, you can walk around downtown and visit the cathedral. In the afternoon we will invite you to a river cruise to enjoy the journey along the River Rhine. If you are a beer fan, try the local "kölsch". Overnight (B).

DAY 4 COLOGNE - AMSTERDAM



Breakfast at the Hotel. Departure towards Holland. Take your train to Amsterdam. Upon arrival, a driver will pick you up and drive you to the hotel. Check-in and free time to explore

the city at your own pace, stroll through the historic center and visiting the most important attractions

DAY 5 AMSTERDAM - BRUSSELS

Breakfast at the hotel. After checking out, take the train to Brussels, capital of Belgium. Once in Brussels, our driver will be waiting for you to take you to the hotel for the check-in. After a

short break, take a walk to the most popular attractions of Brussels such as the Grand Palace, Manneken Pis, Royal Square, the Sablon, the Palace of Justice and others. DAY 6 BRUSSELS Day trip to the medieval city of Bruges

Explore the picturesque Market Square dominated by the soaring Belfry tower, discover hidden courtyards and scenic bridges perfect for photos, and wander cobblestone streets lined with chocolate shops and lace boutiques. On this tour, your guide will take you on a journey of discovery through the historic heart of the city and show you the highlights of medieval Bruges. He will tell you fascinating stories and ancient legends, and at the same time give you valuable tips on where to go and what to do in present-day Bruges. History and funny stories, legends and interesting facts, highlights and hidden gems — this tour has everything to make your experience of Bruges authentic and unforgettable! When you've soaked in the fairy-tale atmosphere, your driver will transport you comfortably back to Brussels, completing a perfect day in one of Europe's most enchanting destinations. Overnight (B)

DAY 7 BRUSSELS - PARIS

THE OFF BY TRAIN

Breakfast at the Hotel. The journey continues to France. Go to the train station at the given time and board your train to Paris. Once in Paris, transfer with a private car to the hotel. In

the afternoon go for a walk in the city center, visiting some of the most important attractions at your own pace such as the Cathedral of Notre Dame, the City Palace, the Holy Chapel (Sainte Chapelle) and Montmartre among others. Also explore on your own the big shopping malls in Paris or visit one of the many museums (The most interesting are the War Museum with the Napoleon's Tomb, The Grevin Wax Museum and the Museum D'Orsay. Overnight. (B)

DAY 8 PARIS

Breakfast. In the morning discover Paris's most famous tourist sights and monuments on one unique tour. This tour features a visit to the 3rd floor of the Eiffel Tower with breathtaking views of the capital, a panoramic city tour by coach, plus an hour-long boat trip along the Seine. This comprehensive tour is the ideal way to discover Paris for the first time. Thanks to your priority access, you can skip the line and speed up by elevator to the 3rd floor of Eiffel Tower, Paris's most unmissable monument. Built by Gustave Eiffel for the Universal Exhibition in 1889, it is 1,063 feet high. Take in the magnificent 360° views of the city and explore this iconic monument at your own pace. Your tour continues with a panoramic coach offering you the opportunity to see Paris and learn about its history and most famous sights through an audio guide commentary (individual headsets). Take a seat aboard our covered panoramic bus for a unique experience. You will leave for a Paris visit with your audioguide adapted to the whole family. You will discover the central districts and monuments of Paris, from the Champs Elysées to the Louvre and the Eiffel Tower. Your children can share with you this funny experience while learning. You will discover many other monuments and famous Parisian places like the Arc de Triomphe, the musée d'Orsay, the Place de la Concorde, Saint Germain des Prés, the Conciergerie or Notre-Dame de Paris cathedral. At the foot of the Eiffel Tower, you will step an audio guided hour-long Seine river cruise aboard. Marvel at the fantastic architecture of the heart of Paris's most prestigious monuments lining the banks of the Seine: the Louvre Museum, Notre Dame Cathedral, the Orsay Museum, the Conciergerie, etc. Relax on the fullyglassed boat with terrace, and be captivated by this river trip among Parisians who walk and cycle beside the river as you glide by. Your excursion will end at the Eiffel Tower. Overnight. (B).





DAY 9 PARIS

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you will depart to Versailles on a guided tour. This was a sleepy village until Louis XIII began to build a hunting lodge there in 1623. By the end of the century, continued expansion saw the town and castle become the symbolic centre of the absolute monarchy of the Ancien Régime. You will visit the State Apartments built by Le Vau. Get a sense of life in the French court as you take a walk through the glittering Hall of Mirrors. Stroll through the legendary gardens at your own pace, and admire fountains, sculptures, and beautifully manicured lawns. After visiting the Palace, we will come back to Paris. In the afternoon, visit at your own pace the Museum El Louvre (entrance ticket included), considered the most important museum in the world, for the richness of its collections and the influence it has had on the other museums in the world. It is the most visited art museum in the world and the most remembered by several of his masterpieces, like the Mona Lisa by Leonardo da Vinci. At the evening we recommend you to attend one of the most popular musicals of Paris, the "Moulin Rouge" in the bohemian Montmartre or "The Lido" at the Champs Elysees. Both are very good and there is not a marked difference in both the show and food. You have the decision! (B)

DAY 10 PARIS - LYON

Breakfast at t

Breakfast at the hotel. Today your journey continues south toward the gastronomic capital of France: Lyon. Travel by high-speed train through the beautiful French

countryside. Upon arrival in Lyon, a private transfer will take you to your hotel for check-in. In the afternoon, enjoy a walking tour through the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Old Town (Vieux Lyon), with its Renaissance mansions, cobbled streets, and famous traboules (hidden passageways). Discover the imposing Basilica of Notre-Dame de Fourvière, perched on the hilltop with panoramic views over the city. In the evening, take advantage of Lyon's celebrated culinary scene with dinner at a traditional "bouchon" (not included). Overnight in Lyon. **(B)**

DAY 11 LYON - NICE



Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a relaxing morning in Lyon to visit local markets or stroll along the Rhône and Saône rivers. Then transfer to the station to board your train

heading south toward Nice, the jewel of the Côte d'Azur. On arrival, private transfer to your hotel and check-in. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure exploring the Promenade des Anglais, the old town (Vieux Nice) with its colorful buildings, and the bustling Cours Saleya market. Overnight in Nice. (B)

DAY 12 NICE Journey to the Còte d'Azur



Breakfast. Enjoy and discover one of the nicest French regions, the French Riviera or Cote d'Azur. During the day and using your train pass, you can discover several cities including Cannes and Saint Tropez where you can have lunch in a nice restaurant. You will help you

to plan your day of course and give you some tips to profit the day. Overnight in Nice.

DAY 13 NICE Discovering Montecarlo in Monaco



Breakfast at the hotel. Today we will offer you a full day journey to Monte Carlo, the capital of Monaco, a principality at the Mediterranean Sea and famous for its Casino and

the Formule One Race through its streets. Our guide will be waiting for you at the train station and will take you to the most important highlights of the city including a visit to the Castle (from outside) as well as the casino, where you can try your luck. In the afternoon, back to Nice to your hotel. Overnight. (B)
