You will start your journey visiting the Pyramids and the Great Sphinx, you will discover the Old Cairo and its turbulent streets with lots of vendors and explore many Islamic and Coptic sites like The Amr Ibn Ass Mosque, the Hanging Church and the Ben Ezra Synagogue.

Continue exploring the ancient Egypt aboard a cruise ship sailing on the Nile and visiting the imposing archaeological sites of Kom Ombo, Luxor, the Valley of kings and Karnak. Not only will you experience history up close, but you'll also enjoy the great gastronomy aboard this ship. Come and live your cultural adventure with EUROLATINO.

DAY 01 (Tuesday) ARRIVAL IN CAIRO

After the international flight, arrive at Cairo airport where you will meet our representative who will assist you through customs and procedures at the airport. Transfer to your hotel on a modern air-conditioned bus. Arrival and registration at the hotel. The rest of the day is free for private activities, for shopping or visiting museums. Overnight at the Grand Pyramids Hotel (4****) or similar.

DAY 02 (Wednesday) THE CAIRO Pyramids and Egyptian Museum

Today, after breakfast, we begin to explore ancient Egypt with a visit to the famous pyramids. The hand-built Great Pyramid of Cheops is the largest of the three main pyramids and is the only survivor of the Seven Great Wonders of the Ancient World. The other two are the pyramid of Chephren, which is the best preserved, and the Pyramid of Mykerinus. Nearby you can see the Sphinx, a wonderful sculpture carved from a natural rocky outcrop. The lion's body extends for 45 m and the legs are 15 m long. We will offer you also a complementary 10-minutes camel ride before we go to visit the Papyrus Institute and learn how the paper was made in ancient times, followed by shopping at the Papyrus Museum, perfume factory and jewelry. Afterwards we will go back to the hotel. The afternoon and evening is at leisure so you can visit at your own pace the famous Egyptian Museum, where you will spend two hours in the richest Museum in the world learning about the history of Ancient Egypt, especially the part of King Tut with the masterpiece: his golden mask. Accommodation at the Grand Pyramids Hotel or similar. (4****) (B)

DAY 03 (Thursday) CAIRO Full day walking tour in old downtown Cairo with local food

Breakfast at the hotel. Join your group in the lobby and meet your Egyptologist guide to start a wonderful Full Day tour to explore unseen real side of the city and visit Old Cairo with Islamic & Coptic Sites (Amr Ibn El Ass Mosque, Ahmed Ibn Toloun Mosque, Pass by the Citadel of Salah El Din, Hanging Church, Abu Serga Church and Ben Ezra Synagogue). Later, we are going to introduce you to the best Egyptian bites so you can eat like a local and enjoy all the traditional food and beverage of Cairo and leave you with a full belly. Spend 3 hours exploring delicious types of food and learn about their recipes and ingredients. This food tour is designated for foodies who like to try typical local cuisine. The tour is not only about food, but you will discover the history, daily life activities, customs and traditions through the walking tour on the streets of Cairo. DAY 04 (Friday) CAIRO - ASWAN

Early breakfast. Transfer to Cairo International Airport and flight to Aswan. Upon arrival, reception and welcome by our representative in Egypt. Transfer to the pier for boarding on the Nile cruise-ship with full board (buffet, no drinks). After leaving your luggage, meet your English-speaking guide, visit the gigantic dam of the modern era, built by the Egyptians, the "High Dam of Aswan". We will also see the unfinished Obelisk. After the visit, return to the cruise for check-in and have lunch. Evening is free at leisure to do some optional excursions which will be offered by your guide according to availability or simply enjoy your stay on the cruise. Dinner and accommodation aboard the M/S Nile Dolphin (or similar) in Aswan (B) (L) (D)

DAY 05 (Saturday) ASWAN – KOM OMBO - EDFU

After breakfast, optional visit to the Temple of Abu Simbel, where you will see two majestic temples and the impressive Temple of Ramses II (the most interesting temple is the shrine, where there are four statues, one of Ramses II). After that return to the boat. If you prefer, you can stay on board and enjoy the cruise facilities. After lunch we will sail to Kom Ombo. Visit the Temples of the Gods Sobek (crocodile) and Horus. Back on the cruise-ship, we'll sail to Edfu. After a short break, carriage transfer to the Temple of "Horus" (Hawk), Power of God and a general visit. Back to the ships and sail to Luxor. Dinner and Overnight in Luxor aboard the MS Nile Dolphin or similar (5 *****). (B) (L) (D)

DAY 06 (Sunday) LUXOR

Breakfast onboard of the cruise. Transfer to enjoy visiting the major sightseeing in Luxor which includes West Bank (The Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Temple and the Colossi of Memnon) & East Bank (Karnak temples, Mosque Abu El Hagag, Panorama of Luxor Temple & Sphinxes Avenue). Back to the cruise and lunch onboard of the cruise. Evening is free at leisure to do some optional excursions if time permitted or simply enjoy your stay on the cruise and be ready to travel back to Cairo the next day. Dinner & overnight onboard of the cruise. (B) (L) (D)

DAY 07 (Monday) LUXOR - CAIRO

Breakfast on board and check-out. On time transfer to Luxor Airport for your flight back to Cairo and connect to your international flight back to your country. End of our services. (B)
