

# **CULTURAL EGYPT**

## 7 Days/ 6 Nights

In Cairo, the new Egyptian Museum opens its doors to treasures that once belonged only to kings, including the dazzling legacy of Tutankhamun.

From there, the **Nile** becomes your pathway through history. Aboard a comfortable cruise ship, you'll drift between legendary temples and sacred tombs—Kom Ombo, where crocodile gods were once worshipped, **Edfu** with its towering columns, and Luxor, the world's greatest open-air museum. In the Valley of the Kings, you'll walk the corridors where pharaohs prepared for eternity, guided by an expert in Egyptology who brings every carving and symbol to life.

This journey is more than sightseeing. It is tasting **Egypt**'s vibrant cuisine, feeling the rhythm of the **Nile** at sunset, and standing in places where myths and history merge. Perfectly balanced between discovery and relaxation, this 7-day adventure is designed for those who seek culture, inspiration, and the thrill of walking in the footsteps of ancient civilization. Come with **EUROLATINO** and live your own story in the land of the pharaohs.

## DAY 01 (Saturday) ARRIVAL IN CAIRO

After the international flight, arrive at Cairo airport where you will meet our representative who will assist you through the customs and procedures at the airport. Transfer to your hotel on a modern air-conditioned bus. Arrival and registration at the hotel. The rest of the day is free for private activities, for shopping or visiting museums. Overnight at Hotel Concorde El Salam Cairo (Hotel 5 \*\*\*\*\*) or similar.

## DAY 02 (Sunday) CAIRO Pyramids and Egyptian Museum

Today, after breakfast, we begin to explore ancient Egypt with a visit to the famous pyramids. The hand-built Great Pyramid of Keops is the largest of the three main pyramids and is the only survivor of the Seven Great Wonders of the Ancient World. The other two are the pyramid of Chephren, which is the best preserved, and the Pyramid of Mycerinus. Nearby you can see the Sphinx, a wonderful sculpture carved from a natural rocky outcrop. The lion's body extends for 45 m and the legs are 15 m long. We will visit the Papyrus Institute and learn how the paper was made in ancient times, followed by shopping at the Papyrus Museum, perfume factory and jewelry. Afterwards we will visit the famous Egyptian Museum, where you will spend two hours in the richest Museum in the world accompanied by our English-speaking guide and enjoying his explanation of history, especially the part of King Tut with the masterpiece: his golden mask. Then transfer back to the hotel. Accommodation at Hotel Concorde El Salam Cairo (5 \*\*\*\*\*) (B)

#### DAY 03 (Monday) CAIRO - ALEXANDRIA - CAIRO

Breakfast at the hotel. Early Morning our tour guide will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo to start your amazing tour to the beautiful city Alexandria through (Cairo- Alexandria) Desert Road. Alexandria was founded by Alexander the Great in 312 B.C. and was the capital of Graeco-Roman Egypt. Your first stop in this historic city is the Catacombs of Kom ash-Shuqqafa, the largest known Roman burial site in Egypt, which were discovered



accidentally in 1900 when a donkey disappeared through the ground. Descend below ground to visit the tomb and Caracalla Hall. Back above ground, proceed to visit Pompey's Pillar, an 82-foot (25-meter) granite column built to honor Emperor Diocletian, who freed the besieged city and brought food to its starving people. Proceed to visit Morsi Abu El Abbas Mosque. Continue for lunch at a local restaurant, proceed to visit Fort Qaitbay from outside, once considered one of the most important defensive strongholds along the Mediterranean sea coast. It was erected on the exact site of the famous Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world. Finally have the chance to visit Montazah Garden with its wonderful Palm gardens and trees, at the end of your tour drive back to your Hotel Concorde El Salam Cairo or similar (5 \*\*\*\*\*) (B) (L)

## DAY 04 (Tuesday) CAIRO - ASWAN

Early breakfast. Transfer to Cairo International Airport and flight to Aswan. Upon arrival, reception and welcome by our representative in Egypt. Then, accompanied by our Englishspeaking guide, visit the beautiful Philae Temple, dedicated to the worship of Isis, the Goddess of Love. After that, visit the gigantic dam of the modern era, built by the Egyptians, the "High Dam of Aswan". After the visit, transfer to the pier for boarding on the Nile cruise-ship with full board (buffet, no drinks). Dinner and attendance at the Nubian Show Party, accommodation aboard the M/S Nile Dolphin (or similar) in Aswan (B) (L) (D)

#### DAY 05 (Wednesday) ASWAN - KOM OMBO - EDFU

After breakfast, optional visit to the Temple of Abu Simbel, where you will see two majestic temples and the impressive Temple of Ramses II (the most interesting temple is the shrine, where there are four statues, one of Ramses II). After that return to the boat. If you prefer, you can stay on board and enjoy the cruise facilities. After lunch we will sail to Kom Ombo. Visit the Temples of the Gods Sobek (crocodile) and Haroeris. Back on the cruise-ship, we'll go to Edfu. After dinner, attend Galabaiya's party aboard the cruise ship. Overnight in Edfu aboard the MS Nile Dolphin or similar (5 \*\*\*\*\*). (B) (L) (D)

#### DAY 06 (Thursday) EDFU - LUXOR

After breakfast, carriage transfer to the Temple of "Horus" (Hawk), Power of God and a general visit of Edfu. Return to the cruise and pass through the Esna Lock towards Luxor. Lunch on board, transfer to the east bank of Luxor to visit the amazing Abuelagag Mosque, the Luxor Temple and the largest temple in the world, Karnak Temple, dedicated to the worship of the Almighty God of the New Empire "God Aton". Return to the cruise, with free time to enjoy its facilities. Freetime at the old Luxor market. Overnight in Luxor aboard the Nile Dolphin or similar (5 \*\*\*\*\*). (B) (L) (D)

#### DAY 07 (Friday) LUXOR - CAIRO

Breakfast on board and check-out. We visit the Valley of the Kings in the West Bank. We continue our visits with the beautiful Temple of Der el Bahari, dedicated to the funeral worship of Queen Hatshepsut and with the statues of Memnon. Later, transfer to Luxor Airport for your flight back to Cairo and connect to your international flight back to your country. End of our services. (B)
