DAY 1 ISTANBUL Arrival

Upon arrival at Istanbul International Airport, your guide will greet you and transfer you to your hotel. Istanbul, once the capital of the Byzantine, Roman, and Ottoman Empires, is a fascinating city straddling two continents — Europe and Asia. Its streets blend history and modern life, with palaces, mosques, churches, bazaars, and a world-renowned culinary scene. Overnight in Istanbul.

DAY 2 ISTANBUL City Tour

After breakfast, enjoy a full-day tour of the city's most iconic landmarks: The Roman Hippodrome, once the social center of ancient Constantinople, featuring the Obelisk of Theodosius, the Serpentine Column, and the Column of Constantine; The Blue Mosque (Sultanahmet Camii), a masterpiece of 16th-century architecture, famous for its magnificent interior decorated with blue İznik tiles, Hagia Sophia (Ayasofya Camii), the crowning jewel of Byzantine architecture and for over 1,000 years the largest church in the world. DAY 3 ISTANBUL – KUSADASI Bosphorus cruise and domestic flight

After breakfast, enjoy a Bosphorus Cruise, a traditional boat excursion along the strait separating Europe and Asia. Admire Ottoman palaces, historic fortresses, and elegant waterfront mansions from the water. In the afternoon, take a domestic flight to Izmir and transfer to your hotel in Kusadasi, one of the Aegean coast's most charming resort towns. Dinner and overnight in Kusadasi. **(B) (D)**

DAY 4 EPHEBUS Sirince Village Tour

After breakfast, set off on a guided tour of Ephesus, one of the best-preserved ancient cities in the world. Walk along Curetes Street, visit the Temple of Artemis (one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World), the Roman Baths, the Library of Celsus, and the magnificent Great Theatre, which once hosted 25,000 spectators. Later, visit a carpet weaving center, where local artisans preserve one of Turkey's oldest traditions. In the afternoon, explore the village of Sirince, known for its Greek-style architecture and charming hillside houses. Sirince is also famous for its locally made fruit wines — you'll have the chance to taste and learn how they're made. On the way back, stop at a leather goods center offering quality products at factory prices. Overnight in Kusadasi. **(B)**

DAY 5 EPHEBUS – PAMUKKALE Hierapolis Tour

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for Pamukkale, known as the "Cotton Castle," a natural wonder of white calcium terraces formed by thermal spring waters. Visit the ancient city of Hierapolis, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and stroll among its ruins — baths, temples, and the grand necropolis. Enjoy free time to walk across the travertine terraces or soak in the warm thermal pools. **Optional Activities:** Tandem Paragliding: Fly over the white terraces of Pamukkale for an unforgettable bird's-eye view. Hot Air Balloon Ride (next morning): Greet the sunrise from the sky as you float above Pamukkale's stunning landscape. Overnight in Pamukkale at a thermal hotel — relax and enjoy the healing waters of the hot springs. **(B)**

DAY 6 PAMUKKALE – BODRUM

After breakfast, travel to Bodrum, a cosmopolitan seaside gem famous for its crystal-clear waters, lively marina, and medieval castle built by the Knights of St. John. Dinner and overnight in Bodrum. **(B) (D)**

DAY 7 BODRUM Free day

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a full free day to relax or explore at your own pace. Soak up the sun on the beach, stroll through local markets, or choose from several optional activities such as a boat trip, scuba diving, fishing tour, or visiting a nearby aqua park. Overnight in Bodrum. **(B)**

DAY 8 BODRUM – ISTANBUL End of tour

After breakfast, transfer to Bodrum Airport for your flight back to Istanbul and your onward international connection.
