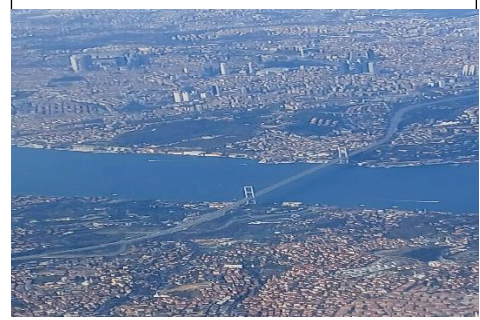

DAY 3 – BOSPHORUS Cruise & Flight to Bodrum

DAY 4 – BODRUM City Tour

Ancient Amphitheatre: Set on a hillside with sweeping views of the city and the sea, this well-preserved structure once hosted concerts and festivals thousands of years ago.

Bodrum beautifully combines ancient heritage with modern sophistication — enjoy its relaxed Mediterranean ambiance before returning to your hotel.

DAY 5 – BODRUM TO FETHIYE

After breakfast, travel south along the coast to Fethiye, one of Turkey's most picturesque seaside towns. Enjoy the scenic drive through olive groves, pine forests, and small villages before arriving in this paradise where the mountains meet the sea.

Dinner and overnight in Fethiye.

DAY 6 – FETHIYE Free Day

Optional activities include: Paragliding from Babadag Mountain, one of the world's most beautiful flight points. Taking a 12 Islands Boat Cruise, with stops at hidden coves and beaches.

Exploring the ancient Lycian rock tombs, carved into cliffs above the city.

Whether you seek relaxation or adventure, Fethiye offers both in abundance.

DAY 7 – FETHIYE TO ANTALYA

After breakfast, drive along the breathtaking coastal route to Antalya, often called the "Turkish Riviera." The journey takes around four hours, with scenic stops along the way. Upon arrival, settle into your hotel and enjoy the sunset over the Mediterranean.

Dinner and overnight in Antalya.

DAY 8 – ANTALYA Free Day

Enjoy a day of leisure in Antalya, surrounded by lush mountains, golden beaches, and ancient ruins. You can wander through the narrow cobblestone streets of Kaleici (Old Town), admire the Roman Hadrian's Gate, or relax on Konyaaltı Beach. Optional tours include rafting in Köprülü Canyon, jeep safaris, or horseback riding through pine forests.
