Continue to the Great Sphinx - guardian of the plateau for over 4,500 years. DAY 4 Friday, July 30 CAIRO - LUXOR National Museum of Egyptian Civilization - Flight to Luxor Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast, visit the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization (NMEC), which spans the full spectrum of Egypt's history—from prehistoric times to modern day. The highlight is the Royal Mummies Hall, where you'll encounter the preserved remains of Egypt's greatest pharaohs. Later, take a short flight to Luxor, the ancient capital of Thebes. Breakfast at the hotel. Venture across the Nile to the West Bank and enter the legendary Valley of the Kings, where the pharaohs of the New Kingdom were laid to rest. Explore several intricately decorated tombs, including that of Tutankhamun (optional). Continue to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, an architectural masterpiece nestled against towering cliffs, then stop at the iconic Colossi of Memnon. 


Breakfast at the hotel. Today is devoted to one of the rarest and most profound astronomical experiences of your lifetime. We depart early to a private viewing site on the outskirts of Luxor, handpicked for its open skies, safety, comfort, and optimal eclipse alignment. Here, surrounded by the timeless landscape of Upper Egypt, we prepare to witness nature's most spectacular celestial event: a total solar eclipse. Upon arrival, guests will be welcomed with refreshments in a shaded lounge area. Our team will provide solar viewing glasses, camera setups, and guidance to help you capture the moment perfectly. As the Moon begins to slide across the face of the Sun, notice the light shift, the air cool, and the shadows sharpen. Birds may go silent. A hush will fall over the land. At 1:05 PM, totality begins. For six minutes and 22 seconds, the Sun disappears behind the Moon, revealing the solar corona in all its ghostly beauty. Stars may twinkle in the day. You'll experience midday darkness in the land of sun worshippers. This event is enhanced by the sacredness of the land around you—where ancient astronomers once charted the stars, and massive stone temples were aligned with solstices and equinoxes. After the eclipse, you'll have time to relax, reflect, and share your impressions with fellow travellers before we return to the hotel. Evening free or optional guided reflection walk along the Nile. DAY 09 Wednesday, August 04 LUXOR WEST BANK –EDFU – KOM OMBO

Breakfast onboard of the cruise. This morning, after we set sail, we'll visit the stunning Temple of Edfu, one of the best-preserved temples in all of Egypt. As you explore this majestic site, you'll be transported back in time to a place where the grandeur of ancient Egypt still stands proudly. After our visit, we'll return to the boat and continue our journey down the Nile, heading toward Kom Ombo. Its tempel is unique since it is a dual temple, dedicated to two gods: Haroeris, the Sun God, and Sobek, the Crocodile God. Just a short walk from the boat, this fascinating site offers insight into ancient Egyptian religious practices and includes intriguing hieroglyphic carvings depicting medical instruments—some of which are still used in modern medicine today. After our visit, we'll head back to the boat for dinner, followed by a lively cruise party to celebrate the day's adventures! Overnight on-board Nile River Cruise-ship. (B) (L) (D)

DAY 10 Thursday, August 05 EDFU – ASWAN Optional excursion to Abu Simbel

Breakfast onboard the ship. Today begins with an early start as we embark on a 3.5-hour drive south to the awe inspiring Abu Simbel Temples—a highlight of any visit to Egypt and widely considered the most impressive of all the temples we explore. Carved deep into solid rock, these temples were built by Pharaoh Ramses II and dedicated to him and his beloved wife Nefertari. The grandeur and scale of the site will leave you speechless. In the 1960s, the temples were relocated to their current position, higher up the riverbank, to protect them from the rising waters of the Nile. This incredible feature of engineering, carried out with the help of UNESCO, is a testament to the skill and determination involved in preserving these ancient wonders. Once you've experienced Abu Simbel in person, you'll understand why it's one of Egypt's most iconic sites. After our visit, we'll return to Aswan for lunch on board our cruise boat. In the afternoon, we'll relax as we sail along the picturesque Nile River on a traditional felucca boat, much like those used by the ancient Pharaohs. Enjoy the serenity of the river as we drift through the tranquil landscapes of Aswan. Dinner and overnight onboard the cruise-ship. (B) (L) (D)

DAY 11 Friday, August 06 **ASWAN**

Breakfast onboard the cruise. This morning, after breakfast, we'll disembark from our Nile River Cruise and begin our exploration in Aswan. First, we'll visit Philae Temple, dedicated to the Goddess Isis, one of Egypt's most revered deities. Next, we'll head to the High Dam, a marvel of modern engineering that controls the flow of the Nile, and the Unfinished Obelisk, a fascinating site that gives insight into the ancient quarrying process. In the afternoon, we'll take our return flight to Cairo. Upon arrival our representative will be waiting for you to transfer you to your hotel. Overnight in Cairo. (B)
