DAY 1 AMSTERDAM Arrival

Arrival in Amsterdam and private transfer to your hotel. After check-in, enjoy time to rest and begin exploring the city at your leisure. Wander along the canals or visit one of Amsterdam's exceptional museums—the Van Gogh Museum, Rembrandt House, or the Anne Frank House. Tickets can be arranged upon request. Overnight in a selected 4**** hotel.

DAY 2 AMSTERDAM City Walk & Canal Cruise

Breakfast at the hotel. Embark today on a walking tour in Amsterdam to witness the charm of its iconic canals, admire the historic architecture along the Jordaan district, and soak in the lively atmosphere of Dam Square with its bustling street life and vibrant attractions. After the tour, glide along Amsterdam's waterways during a one-hour river cruise, soaking in the city's picturesque beauty. Rest of the day at leisure for private activities, shopping or explore the Red Light District, a special quarter in the city. Overnight in Amsterdam. (B)

DAY 3 AMSTERDAM Traditional charm

Breakfast to the hotel. Today we offer a day trip that you surely cannot miss: windmills, dams, medieval towns and an island below sea level. Barely 20 km away from the capital you can find the true essence of Holland in the evergreen countryside. The impressive windmills of Zaanse Schans are just the appetizer of this adventure. We will visit Edam, an authentic jewel of the 14th century surrounded by extensive green meadows. We will make our stop to eat and rest in Volendam, a fishing village known for its picturesque port, and we will finish our tour with a visit to Marken, an old fishing island with just over a thousand inhabitants. DAY 4 AMSTERDAM – BRUSSELS Flemish charm

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure from the hotel early in the morning. Venture beyond the borders of Holland, as your private bus whisks you away to Brussels. Arrival in the Belgian capital and check-in at the selected hotel. In the afternoon, Brussels invites you to explore its cobblestone streets and unique charm. A city tour unfolds the stories embedded in its architecture. Highlights that you will see include the Grand Place (Grote Markt), a UNESCO World Heritage site, the gothic Cathedral of St. Michael and St. Gudula, the Royal Palace with the Parc de Bruxelles, the Sablon District known for its antique shops, chocolatiers, and art galleries and of course, the emblematic "Manequin pis", a small bronze sculpture of a naked little boy urinating into a fountain's basin. The statue is known for its whimsical and sometimes irreverent sense of humor. Finally, we continue to see the Atomium, an iconic spheric structure and museum that was built for the 1958 World Expo representing atoms in an iron crystal magnified 165 billion times before we enjoy the Europe in Miniature Park for a while, that provides a fascinating perspective on the continent's diversity, and it features replicas of famous landmarks from European countries in a scaled-down size. DAY 5 Tuesday BRUSSELS - BRUGGE - PARIS Medieval charm

Breakfast to the hotel. Departure to Bruges, where a guided tour will unveil its architectural treasures. Bruges, often referred to as the "Venice of the North," is a picturesque medieval city in Belgium known for its enchanting canals, well-preserved architecture, and cobblestone streets. With its charming market squares and historic buildings, Bruges captivates visitors with its timeless beauty and romantic atmosphere. The journey then takes you to the vibrant city of Paris, the "city of light". After check-in and short time to rest, free time to start discovering the highlights in the city center. Overnight. (B)

DAY 6 PARIS Cultural charm

Breakfast at the hotel. At the given time your local guide will meet you at the hotel and you will start a guided visit of the City of Lights. You will walk to the Eiffel Tower and get to the top floor. On the way, your guide will give you some tips and answer your first questions regarding your visit to Paris. Enjoy the Tower Experience and the amazing view from the top. There is no limit to stay on the top floor. However, I recommend before going down again, to get the macarons that are sold on the shopping kiosk. They are the best. Continue discovering the incredibly rich heritage of Paris with the best itinerary, unveiling charming places like the Isle of France where Notre Dame is located, Hôtel de Ville, Garden of the Tulleries where Le Louvre is located, Place Vendôme, Opéra, Concorde, Madeleine, Champs-Élysées, Arc de Triomphe... After the visit, you will have free time to eat something or just to stroll around the city center for more experiences in the French capital. Overnight. B)

DAY 7 PARIS Imperial charm

Breakfast at the hotel. Your Parisien Experience continues today with another awesome excursion. You will start a guided tour to Versailles, a magnificent Palais in the outskirts from Paris. The Chateau de Versailles is one of the world's most visited historic sites! The Palace of Versailles, a UNESCO World Heritage site, was the residence of French Kings Louis XIV, Louis XV, and Louis XVI and their courts, from 1682 until the French Revolution in 1789. Its Baroque decoration, artworks and furniture were all created by the greatest craftsmen of the period. Imagine how the extravagance of Versailles was part of everyday life for Marie Antoniette while your guide explains to you the daily life at the Palais. Gaze in wonder at the Royal Apartments and the Queen's Apartments and walk through the glittering Hall of Mirrors. After your tour, explore the stunning French-style gardens at your own pace before you come back to Paris for your next experience, either shopping in the Grande Boulevards or visiting one of the most beautiful Museums in Paris with the impressionism as highlight, the D'Orsay Museum. At a given time, we will meet at the pier and embark on one "bateaux", a cruise boat specially adapted to experience a great dinner while you see the city of lights from other perspective navigating on the waters of the Seine River. Finally, after a day full of experiences, the cruise ends at the Eiffel Tower Pier after dinner. (B) (D)





DAY 8 PARIS - STRASSBOURG Cultural charm

Breakfast to the hotel. In the morning, you will visit one of the most famous museums of the world, the Louvre Museum. Your priority access ticket will allow you to follow your guide straight into the world's largest museum. No need to stand in line! This guided tour offers the perfect opportunity to learn about the museum's huge collection and its greatest works of art, such as the Mona Lisa, the Venus de Milo, and the Coronation of Napoleon. After the guided tour, return to the hotel for checkout, then transfer to the train station for your high-speed journey to Strasbourg. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel and enjoy a free evening to explore the Alsatian capital. Overnight. (B)

DAY 9 STRASSBOURG - COLMAR Alsatian charm

DAY 10 ZÜRICH Swiss charm and waterfalls

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, embark on a guided city tour in Strasbourg, where the charm of its historic Old Town unfolds through captivating tales of Alsatian heritage and iconic landmarks like the Strasbourg Cathedral. In the afternoon, continue to Colmar and immerse yourself in free-spirited exploration amidst cobblestone streets, vibrant canals, and half-timbered houses. Colmar's old-world charm and cultural richness make it a delightful destination for discovering Alsatian treasures at your own pace. Overnight in Colmar. (B)

Breakfast to the hotel. In the morning you will take a train to go to Zurich in Switzerland. After a short break, we will help you to experience all of the outstanding things Zurich has to offer in one singular sightseeing tour. The route leads across the famous Bahnhofstrasse (shopping street of Zurich) and the Banking Center to the lake with a view of the snowcapped mountains, part of the old town with its magnificent guild houses and the churches St. Peter, Grossmünster and Fraumünster. After a picture stop at Lake Zürich, pass by the Opera House and experience a ride uphill by cogwheel train to a great viewpoint. Take in breath-taking vistas of the city, the lake and the snow-capped Alps before cruising the University quarter, the theatre and the art museum. Reach the charming Old Town and admire the town hall, Zürich's emblematic churches and the medieval guild houses. A short stroll along the picturesque Limmat brings you to nearby Bürkliplatz. Embark on a scenic one-hour cruise on crystal-clear Lake Zurich past grand lakeside villas and popular lidos. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at the selected hotel. (B)

DAY 11 Sunday ZÜRICH Alpin charm in the glacier

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you will live a thrilling and unforgettable full-day excursion to Jungfraujoch - Top of Europe! and listed by UNESCO as "World Heritage Site of the Swiss Alps". After a scenic ride through the Bernese Oberland. And a short break in Interlaken, a picturesque village nestled idyllically between Lakes Brienz and Thun, continue to Grindelwald where you will board the Eiger Express aerial cableway to reach the mighty Eiger North Face. Arrive at the Glacier Eiger station and change to the coghweel train through tunnels carved into the hard rock over a century ago to the summit of the Jungfraujoch. At the top, immerse yourself in a fascinating alpine world of eternal snow and ice and enjoy time at leisure to discover the summit attractions individually, such as the Alpine Sensation discovery tour and visit the Sphinx Observation Terrace for the most breathtaking panoramic view of the snow-capped peaks, the neighbouring countries and the longest glacier in the Alps, the Aletsch Glacier. Explore also the Ice Palace tunnels in the heart of the glacier. Take a souvenir photo with the famous Swiss flag on the Plateau before recovering your strength at one of the available restaurants and start your descent by cogwheel train via Kleine Scheidegg, the car-free holiday destination of Wengen and the famous Lauterbrunnen valley, where your coach awaits you for the return journey. DAY 12 ZÜRICH

Breakfast at the hotel. The day is at leisure for private activities while you wait for your transfer to the airport. Once at the airport, end of our services. (B)
