If your timing is right, experience the world's most famous festival, Oktoberfest, where laughter, music, and frothy steins of beer set the stage for memories that last a lifetime.

From Germany, we journey to the magical cities of Prague, Budapest, and Vienna, following the legacy of the Habsburg dynasty. In **Prague**, stroll across the iconic Charles Bridge and explore the grandeur of Prague Castle. In Vienna, admire the opulent Hofburg Palace, the splendor of Schönbrunn, and savor the world-famous Sacher Torte. In **Budapest**, experience the elegance of the Danube's banks and the city's architectural gems, feeling the pulse of **Europe**'s imperial past.

Our adventure continues in Italy, where history and art flourish. In Florence, walk the streets that nurtured the Renaissance, from the Duomo to the Ponte Vecchio. Discover the romance of **Venice**, gliding along its canals amid architectural wonders. In Rome, witness the majesty of the Colosseum, the Pantheon, and the treasures of the Vatican, where art, culture, and history converge in the Eternal City. Finally, we cross the Mediterranean to Barcelona, a city that vibrates with creativity and life. Explore Gaudi's masterpieces, from the Sagrada Familia to Park Güell, stroll through the Gothic Quarter, and venture to Montserrat or the Costa Brava to embrace the natural beauty that inspired Salvador Dalí. This is more than a tour—it's a celebration of discovery, culture, and shared experiences. Join us to walk in the footsteps of kings, artists, and visionaries, to taste, explore, and create memories that will stay with you forever. **Europe** awaits—come and live your cosmopolitan adventure!

DAY 1 INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT - MUNICH

Arrival in Munich on your international flight and meet your driver at the airport, who will assist you and accompany you to the hotel. Check-in and free time for personal activities. Overnight.

DAY 2 MUNICH

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, we will visit Munich, the capital and largest city of the German state of Bavaria. Located on the River Isar, north of the Bavarian Alps, Munich is Germany's thirdlargest city, after Berlin and Hamburg. Enjoy a guided walking tour through the historic center, including Karlstor Gate, Munich Cathedral (Frauenkirche), Odeon Square, and Marienplatz, where the Town Hall is located. Return to the hotel. At the scheduled time, you will head to the Hofbräuhaus restaurant, known for its lively Oktoberfest-style atmosphere. (B) (D)

DAY 3 (Jueves 21 de Septiembre) MUNICH

Breakfast at the hotel. Embark on a magical journey through Bavaria's royal heritage with a full-day excursion to Neuschwanstein and Linderhof, the dreamlike castles of King Ludwig II. Begin with a visit to Linderhof Palace, the king's only fully completed residence, inspired by French baroque style and surrounded by beautifully manicured gardens and fountains. Continue through the scenic Bavarian Alps to the fairytale Neuschwanstein Castle, whose soaring towers and dramatic setting inspired Disney's Sleeping Beauty Castle. If you come during the Oktoberfest days, you can choose to participate on this famous folk festival. Enjoy delicious Bavarian food and the best beer served in 1-liter mugs of the beverage everyone loves. (B)

DAY 4 MUNICH - PRAGUE

After breakfast, we begin our journey north toward the Czech Republic. Upon arrival in Prague, we will check in at the hotel and take a short break to rest. In the afternoon, we start our guided tour on foot and by bus through the city, traveling back in time to Prague Castle, built in the 9th century and commonly known as one of the largest castle complexes in the world. Prague's New Town and Old Town such as the National Theatre, Rudolfinum, Powder Tower, Wenceslas Square, and the Dancing House. Upon reaching the castle, you will have free time to explore the area and enjoy lunch at your own pace. Then, cross the Vltava River via the historic Charles Bridge and immerse in Prague's rich history and culture as you cruise along the river. Walk through Palach Square, Parizska Avenue, and Prague's Jewish Quarter. Continue to the Old Town Square to see the historic Town Hall and the world-famous Astronomical Clock, dating back to the 15th century. Your incredible day ends in front of the State Theatre. Return to the hotel. **(B)**

DAY 5 PRAGA - CESKY KRUMLOV - BUDWEIS - VIENNA

After breakfast, continue your journey through the Czech Republic. Your next destination is Budweis, the city where the country's most famous brewery—and one of the most recognized in the world—is located. Upon arrival, we will tour the Budweiser Brewery, observing the production process from start to finish, including bottling. We will also taste various types of beer directly from the storage tanks. After the visit, we continue to the town of Český Krumlov. Situated on the banks of the Vltava River, this town grew around a 13th-century castle that features Gothic, Renaissance, and Baroque elements. Because it has remained almost intact, it has preserved its typical medieval street layout. After the visit, you will continue to Vienna, the capital of Austria. (B)

DAY 6 VIENNA

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you will have a guided tour of Vienna, a city set along the Danube River and at the foothills of the Alps. Its historic center has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site and universally recognized as the musical capital of Europe. We begin with a walking tour through the city, seeing major highlights such as St. Stephen's Cathedral, the historic center with the Hofburg Palace, and the Ringstrasse, where we will admire stunning architecture and important buildings such as the Opera House. Free afternoon to stroll, shop, or rest. We recommend to visit the elegant Hotel Sacher, a 5-star hotel, where you can enjoy a coffee, take in the ambiance, and taste the famous Sacher Torte. Also, we suggest to attend a performance at the Vienna State Opera, a magnificent venue with a world-class classical program. (B)

DAY 7 VIENNA - KLAGENFURTH

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, we head to Schönbrunn Palace, the summer residence of the monarchy. Owned by the Habsburgs from 1569 until the end of the monarchy in 1918, Schönbrunn is one of the most beautiful Baroque palaces in Europe. The palace has a total of 1,441 rooms, of which 45 are open to visitors, and its interiors are decorated in exquisite Rococo style. The Hall of Mirrors at Schönbrunn once hosted performances by a young prodigy, Mozart. Today, the palace is a UNESCO World Heritage Site due to its historical importance, unique character, and magnificent architecture. In the afternoon, we continue south through Austria to the small lakeside town of Klagenfurth am Wörthersee, a medieval town on the shores of the lake in the eastern foothills of the Alps. Free time to stroll around. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 8 KLAGENFURTH - VENICE

Breakfast at the hotel. The morning is free to enjoy Klagenfurth's historic center or take a boat ride on the lake. In the afternoon, depart for Italy, with your first destination being Venice, the City of Love—one of the most romantic cities in the world and, without a doubt, the most beautiful man-made city. After check-in at the hotel, enjoy free time to explore. (B)

DAY 9 VENICE - PADUA - FLORENCE

Breakfast at the hotel. On a guided walking tour, we will see the Doge's Palace, a symbol of Venice's glorious past, the legendary Bridge of Sighs, and much more. You will also have free time to wander the canals at your own pace, enjoy the architecture, and perhaps take a ride in a traditional Venetian gondola. In the afternoon continue to Florence. Check-in at the hotel **(B)**

DAY 10 FLORENCE

Breakfast at the hotel. Guided tour of Florence, the cradle of the Renaissance. We begin at Piazza Santa Maria Novella, then visit Piazza San Lorenzo, closely linked to the powerful Medici family. Next is Piazza del Duomo, featuring Giotto's Campanile, the Baptistery, and the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore. At Piazza della Repubblica, discover the heart and true essence of Florence. We continue to Piazza della Signoria, considered by many the city's most beautiful square. At the





Palazzo Vecchio, we make our last stop before reaching the famous Ponte Vecchio. After the tour, free time to explore the city at your own pace, or take an optional tour to Pisa or Cinque Terra. **(B) DAY 11 FLORENCE**

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you will have Tuscany in one day, a tour that combines culture, architecture and wine. Your bus leaves for the Chianti region to Monteriggioni, a real gem set in the Tuscan hills, a small medieval town characterised by its still intact walls and charming piazza, where you will have free time to breathe in the atmosphere of ancient times. Continue to Siena, the medieval city characterised by the marvellous Piazza del Campo, famous for its Palio and the examples of Gothic civil architecture that reside there. After that it is time to head to the wonderful CHIANTI region with its lush postcard-perfect landscapes. You will enjoy the best Chianti wine in a picturesque wine cellar, accompanied by mouth-watering homemade snacks and a rich wine and oil tasting. Finally, you will visit San Gimignano, a picturesque and evocative medieval town, declared a UNESCO 'World Heritage Site' and famous for its white winerical centre and to admire the breathtaking landscape surrounding San Gimignano. Return to Florence late in the evening. **(B) (L)**

DAY 12 FLORENCE - ROME

Breakfast at the hotel. Today we travel to Rome, the Eternal City, where history comes alive through stories of Julius Caesar, Augustus, Nero, and Trajan. Begin your journey at the majestic Colosseum, then stroll through the city to witness landmarks shaped by the great emperors. Pass Piazza Venezia, admire the monument to Vittorio Emanuele II, and explore Campidoglio Square, designed by Michelangelo, featuring the famous she-wolf statue of Romulus and Remus. Continue to Piazza Navona and the iconic Trevi Fountain. Overnight in Rome. (B)

DAY 13 ROME - VATICAN - CIVITAVECCHIA

After breakfast, visit the Vatican City with exclusive "Skip the Line" access to the Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's Basilica, home to one of the world's greatest art collections. Walk through the galleries of tapestries and maps, admire Raphael's Rooms, and marvel at Michelangelo's masterpiece in the Sistine Chapel. Conclude at St. Peter's Square, then enjoy free time to explore the city or join optional tours. In the evening, board the ferry across the Mediterranean to Spain, with dinner on board and leisure time to enjoy the ship's amenities, including a disco, games room, and bars. Overnight in an outside cabin. (B) (D)

DAY 14 (Lunes 2 de Octubre) AT SEA

Breakfast on board. Spend the day at sea relaxing, swimming in the pool, enjoying the spa, or simply taking in the views. Lunch will be served on board. In the evening, arrive in Barcelona, Catalonia's capital and Spain's second-largest city. Transfer to the hotel. Enjoy free time. (B) (L)

DAY 15 (Martes 3 de Octubre) BARCELONA

Breakfast at the hotel. Explore Barcelona today, starting with its main avenues and Gaudí's modernist masterpieces: Casa Milà, La Pedrera, and Casa Batlló, all UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Visit Montjuïc Park for panoramic city and harbor views, the Olympic Ring, Columbus Monument, and the Olympic Port. Continue to the Sagrada Familia, Gaudí's most iconic work, with its nature-inspired interiors rich in symbolism, then explore Park Güell, another of Gaudí's famous creations. In the evening, enjoy a spectacular Flamenco show with dinner. Overnight in Barcelona. (B) (D).

DAY 16 BARCELONA

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, enjoy a half-day excursion to Montserrat, one of Catalonia's most iconic sites. Travel to the dramatic Montserrat Mountain, where the Benedictine abbey sits perched amid unique rock formations. Explore the Monastery of Montserrat, visit its basilica, and see the revered Black Madonna, a symbol of Catalan devotion. Take in panoramic views of the surrounding landscape and learn about the legends and history of this spiritual and cultural landmark. Return to Barcelona in the afternoon, with free time to explore the city, shop, or relax at your leisure. **(B)**

DAY 17 BARCELONA - AEROPUERTO

Breakfast at the hotel. Free day for personal activities until your transfer to the airport for your return flight home. Your guide will assist with all airport formalities. End of services. **(B)**
