DAY 1 Sunday INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT – PARIS

Intercontinental flight to Paris. Arrival at the international airport. Reception through our partner in France and drive with a private vehicle to the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. In the evening get together with other members of the **1st Rally Europe 2022**. Informations about the details for the next days. Dinner. Overnight. (D)

DAY 2 Monday PARIS

Breakfast at the Hotel. Morning guided tour of the City of Light, along the Champs Elysees, Arc de Triomphe, Eiffel Tower, City Isle, Notredame, the Latin Quarter and much more. In the afternoon we will go for a walk in the city center, visiting some of the most important attractions in Downtown. At the end of the afternoon, we will go to Trocadero and take a cruise on the Seine River. After the boat ride, go to the Eiffel Tower and climb to the top platform where you can enjoy a wonderful view of the City of Light. (B)

DAY 3 Tuesday PARIS - LONDON

Breakfast. Early in the morning we will drive to the dock to board the ferry from Calais to London (451km, 5h 16m). Upon arrival, registration at the Hotel. In the afternoon, city tour, visiting Piccadilly Circus, Oxford Street, Houses of Parliament, Buckingham Palace, Royal Residence with the change of the Royal Guard (if weather allows), Westminster Abbey, etc... Dinner at the hotel. Overnight. (B) (D)

DAY 4 Wednesday LONDON - HARWICH

Breakfast at the hotel. We will visit today the Windsor Castle, considered the largest inhabited fortress in the world, the Tower of London with the fantastic collection of British Crown Jewels and the Anglican Cathedral of St. Paul. Afternoon at leisure. Take time to see any of the museums or just walk through the center and the River Thames. At the given time, departure from London and arrival at the Harbour in Harwich (118km, 1h 30m) for embarkation at the Ferry that will take us to Holland. Room distribution. Overnight on board of the ship. (B)

DAY 5 Thursday HOOK OF HOLLAND - AMSTERDAM

Breakfast on board. After arrival around 7:00 o'clock, departure towards Amsterdam (84 Km, 1h 10m). Transfer to Amsterdam on a private vehicle. *On the way, we will visit Rotterdam and Madurodam Miniature Park.* After the visit, you can continue to Amsterdam. Upon arrival, check-in at the hotel. Short briefing about the activities for next day and drive-plan. You can then explore the city at the evening, stroll through the historic center and visiting the most important attractions. **(B)**

DAY 6 Friday AMSTERDAM - BRUSSELS

After breakfast we will visit the Anne Frank House and learn about the history of the Jewish girl who hid with her family from the Nazis in this house for years. Afterwards, continue with a small walk around downtown, visiting the Red Zone or other highlights of the city. In the afternoon, you will pick up the car you are going to use for this rally. Drive to Brussels, capital of Belgium (211 Km, 2h 14m). Overnight at the hotel in Brussels. The night is adequate to walk around and visit the main square **(B)**.

DAY 7 Saturday BRUSSELS-COLOGNE

Breakfast. Guided tour visiting the most popular attractions of Brussels: the Grand Palace, Manneken Pis, Royal Square, the Sablon, the Palace of Justice and others. Departure towards Cologne (212 Km, 2h 10m), a city known for its Gothic cathedral. After registering in the Hotel you can walk around downtown and visit the cathedral. In the evening we can get on board a boat and enjoy the area along the River Rhine (optional). **(B)**

DAY 8 Sunday COLOGNE - HEIDELBERG

Breakfast at the Hotel. Today we will get to our next destination in Heidelberg. On the way, we will make a short stop in Koblenz, a precious city between two important Rivers, the Rhine and the Mosel. We will also see many castles and palaces from the 17th and 18th Century who belonged to rich families who have cultivated wine grapes for years. Upon arrival in Heidelberg check-in and time at leisure. **(B)**

DAY 9 Monday HEIDELBERG - MUNICH

Breakfast at the Hotel. Departure to the south in direction to the Alps and the lake region in Bavaria. The Rally continues to Munich (121km, 1h 46m), the capital and the largest city of the German state of Bavaria. It is located on the River Isar north of the Bavarian Alps. Munich is the third largest city in Germany, behind Berlin and Hamburg. Its native name, *München*, is derived from the Old High German *Munichen*, meaning "by the monks' place". The city's name derives from the monks of the Benedictine order who founded the city; hence the monk depicted on the city's coat of arms. Once in the city, check in at the selected Hotel. Later on, guided walking tour through the historic city center, including Karlstor Gate, and Cathedral of Munich (Frauenkirche), the Odeon Square and the Residence, former palace of the elector kings of Baviera. **(B)**

DAY 10 Tuesday MUNICH

Breakfast. The day is at leisure. Our guide will give you some suggestions to do. Time for shopping and to relax from the stress from prior days. Dinner at the Hofbräuhaus, one of the most famous restaurants and brewery in Munich. Return to the hotel. **(B) (D)**

DAY 11 Wednesday MUNICH-HOHENSWANGAU

Breakfast at the Hotel. We will visit today the area where the Fairy Tale King, Ludwig II lived. Upon arrival, registration at your hotel in Hohenschwangau followed by lunch at the Alpenrose restaurant am See, an idyllic location for a delicious meal surrounded by a dream area. Later on, we will walk to the Hohenschwangau Castle, where the King Maximilian I and his wife Mary lived, together with his sons Ludwig and Otto. After Maximilian's death, Ludwig was named King of Bavaria. Overnight in Hohenschwangau. **(B) (L)**

DAY 12 Thursday HOHENSWANGAU – GARDA LAKE

Breakfast at the Hotel. In the morning, we will visit the famous Castle of Neuschwanstein. We take a bus to climb up to the mountain. Guided tour of the Castle. On the way back after the visit, you can either walk down on a special path enjoying the nature and view or take a horse-coach (not included). After the visit, departure to Italy, heading this time to one of the most beautiful Lakes at the Italian Alps, the Garda Lake (329km, 3h 42m). We will drive on the Highway crossing the Alpine Brenner Pass,





where the "Europabrücke", the highest bridge in Europe is located. We will have enough time to make some stops on the way before arriving at a given time. Check in at the Hotel and dinner. **(B) (D)**

DAY 13 Friday GARDLAKE – VERONA VENICE

Breakfast at the hotel. Continue your rally heading to Verona. Immortalized by William Shakespeare in his famous play "Romeo and Juliet" (86km, 1h 5m). We will enter the city and visit its historic center, especially the Roman Arena, but above all, Juliet's house where you can leave your testimony of love. Then continue up to Venice (115km 1h 29m). Free time to discover this wonderful city. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 14 Saturday VENICE

Breakfast. Walking tour of the city of 118 islands, among others walking to the Piazza San Marco, the Doge's Palace, Bridge of Sighs, etc. Free time on your own to walk through the labyrinthine streets and canals and admire the beautiful contrasts between Palaces at the Grand Canal and the small churches. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 15 Sunday VENICE – BOLOGNA – FLORENCE

Breakfast. Departure to Bologna (153 km, 1h 31m), one of the best-preserved historical cities and the second largest medieval old town in Europe, after that of Venice. Known as "la ciudad roja" because of its red roofs and facades. Visit the historic center, the Plaza Mayor, the church of San Petronio and the two medieval towers that characterize the landscape of the city. In the afternoon, we will continue to Florence (109km 1h 11m). Arrival in the city and register at the hotel. Rest of the day free. **(B)**

DAY 16 Monday FLORENCE

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning visit of the city, the cradle of the Renaissance and the Italian Language. We will walk through this city full of Art, History and Culture, admiring the Cathedral of Santa Maria dei Fiori with its beautifully decorated Campanile and the Baptistry decorated with the famous Gates of Paradise, where familiar personalities like Michelangelo or Dante Alighieri spent a time. Overnight in Florence. **(B)**

DAY 17 Tuesday FLORENCE - PONTOVENERE - GENOA

Breakfast at the hotel. We drive to the Mediterranean Sea. We will visit Pisa on the way (100 km, 1h 4m), with its leaning tower of the twelfth century and the Baptistry in the cathedral, built of marble between 1064 and 1118 in Pisan Romanesque style. Continue to Portovenere, one idyllic fishing village on the coast of Liguria on the Ligurian Sea at the end of the Gulf of La Spezia (91km, 1h 9m). We will visit the ruins of the castle. Free time for lunch at your own in one of the local restaurants at the seashores. In the afternoon drive to Genoa, capital of the province of Liguria (115km, 1h 22m). Upon reaching the city, check-in at the hotel. Get together to plan our days in France. Overnight. **(B)**

DAY 18 Wednesday GENOA - MONTE CARLO - NICE

Breakfast at the hotel. Today we will drive in direction to France, with Nice as our next destination. On the way, visit Monte Carlo, the capital of the Principality of Monaco (182 km, 1h 50m), a city state on the French Riviera famous for its Casino, the Royal Palace and the Grand Prix Formula One. Walk on routes where the Grand Prix develops and visit the most important buildings. Let you absorb for the glamour of the city and the chance to see famous people. Then we continue to Nice (21km, 28m), one of the most important tourist centers of the region of the Cote d'Azur or French Riviera. After registration, we will go for a walk along the Promenade des Anglais a road along the Sea shore. **(B)**

DAY 19 Thursday NICE– COTE D'AZUR – MARSEILLE

Breakfast at the hotel. Drive along the coast and visit the most interesting cities of the famous Blue Coast – Cote d'Azur, like Cannes area, famous for its film festival, and Saint Tropez, known to be the favorite place of the European jet set, where you can have lunch at your own in one of the numerous local restaurants. In the afternoon continue towards Marseille, port city and the second most populous city in France, main industrial and economic center of the country (205 km, 2h 4m). Check-in at the hotel. Farewell dinner. Overnight **(B) (D)**

DAY 20 Friday MARSEILLE – RETURN FLIGHT

Breakfast at the hotel. Take a look at the nice city of Marseille and its Harbour, you will like it. On time transfer to the airport. Go on time to the airport in order to return the car. Assistance for your flight back to your country of origin or your connection to extend your stay in Europe. End of our services. **(B)**
