Guests will stay in carefully selected properties, including **La Selva Eco-Lodge & Retreat**, one of the Amazon's most charming and immersive ecolodges, and a first-class catamaran in the **Galapagos**, offering an intimate, upscale exploration of the Enchanted Islands.

With seamless logistics, expert naturalist guides, and a perfect balance of discovery and relaxation, this journey promises more than a vacation—it is a transformative encounter with some of the most extraordinary environments on Earth.

#### DAY 1 (Tuesday) – QUITO

Arrival in Quito. Upon arrival at Quito International Airport, guests are greeted by our representative and transferred privately to their selected hotel. The remainder of the day is free to rest, acclimate to the altitude, or enjoy optional activities such as a stroll through the historic center or a panoramic view from El Panecillo or the Cable Car. Accommodation: GO Quito Hotel or Patio Andaluz (or similar)

#### DAY 2 (Wednesday) – AMAZON – ECO-LODGE

##### Flight to the Amazon – Start of the Rainforest Experience

After breakfast, an English-speaking guide accompanies guests to the airport for their flight to Coca, gateway to the Amazon. The adventure begins with a scenic river journey and rainforest entrance to La Selva Eco-Lodge & Retreat, a sanctuary of comfort deep within the jungle. Guests settle in for a memorable 3-night stay. The lodge's staff will outline the upcoming activities designed to showcase the region's extraordinary biodiversity. **(B)**

#### DAY 3 & 4 (Thursday & Friday) – AMAZON

##### Full Program at La Selva

Breakfast at the lodge. Over the next two days, travelers enjoy the lodge's full program, typically including:

- ✚ Guided walks through primary rainforest, led by naturalist and Indigenous guides
- ✚ Canoe expeditions on tranquil lagoons and winding creeks
- ✚ Birdwatching opportunities, including macaws, toucans, hoatzins, and countless other species
- ✚ Wildlife spotting: monkeys, caimans, river turtles, and if lucky, elusive mammals
- ✚ Visits to canopy towers for breathtaking views above the forest canopy
- ✚ (Cultural or environmental talks to understand local communities and Amazon conservation efforts)

#### DAY 5 (Saturday) – QUITO

Return to Quito. After breakfast, transfer from the lodge to Coca Airport to take the return flight to Quito (subject to change). Upon arrival in the capital, passengers will be transferred privately to their hotel. The remainder of the day is free to rest, to explore the city enjoying the city's museums, plazas, or gastronomy. **Accommodation:** GO Quito Hotel or Patio Andaluz (or similar). **(B)**

#### DAY 6 (Sunday) – GALAPAGOS CRUISE

##### Departure to Galapagos – Cruise Begins

After breakfast, private transfer from the hotel to the airport with full assistance. Before the flight, passengers will process the **Transit Control Card (TCT)**, a mandatory requirement to enter the archipelago. They will then board the Quito–Galapagos flight (subject to change). Upon arrival, they must pay the **Galapagos National Park entrance fee** (subject to change). The journey continues with boarding the **M/C Endemic Cruise**, where the 4-night naturalist exploration program begins, following Itinerary “C”. Passengers will settle into their cabins, meet the crew, and enjoy their first guided activity. **(B) (L) (D)**

#### DAY 7 to 9 (Monday to Wednesday) – GALAPAGOS CRUISE

##### Galapagos Exploration on M/C Endemic

During these three days, travelers will explore some of the most iconic islands of the archipelago, guided by certified naturalists. Activities include:

- ✚ Daily land and sea excursions to key islands on the itinerary
- ✚ Snorkeling with emblematic marine life: turtles, harmless sharks, colorful fish, manta rays, and more
- ✚ Interpretive walks to observe endemic birds, marine iguanas, and unique geological formations
- ✚ Onboard educational talks on the islands' flora, fauna, and evolutionary processes
- ✚ Premium service on the cruise, including outstanding cuisine, personalized attention, and comfortable rest areas

##### End of Cruise – Return to Quito (

After breakfast, passengers will disembark and transfer to the airport to take the return flight to Quito (subject to change). Upon arrival, a private transfer will take them to the hotel near the airport for greater convenience. **Accommodation:** Wyndham Quito Airport (or similar). **(B)**
