DAY 1 (Wednesday) ARRIVAL IN ATHENS

Arrival in Athens after your international flight. Reception at the airport and transfer to the chosen hotel and registration. Athens is the capital of Greece with a history of more than three thousand years, making it one of the oldest inhabited cities on the planet and which played a fundamental role in the development of democracy and philosophy and which influenced the development of Greece, Rome and Western culture. City rich in archaeological remains, of which the most famous is the Parthenon in the Acropolis, although they are not limited to buildings of the classical Greek era but also include Roman and Byzantine monuments. Enjoy your time at leisure for private activities and explore its streets or discover the Acropolis at your own pace or go shopping on the Plaka District, where you will also find typical restaurants with delicious and fresh menus.

DAY 2 (Thursday) ATHENS

In the morning you will be picked up from your hotel and join a half-day guided tour of Athens, including a bus tour at the Panathenaic Stadium, the Presidential residence, the Temple of Olympian Zeus, the Hadrian's Arch, the Parliament and the memorial of the Unknown Soldier, the Academy, the University, the National Library, the Constitution



DAY 3 (Friday) ATHENS - POROS Embarkation

Breakfast at the hotel. Embarkation at Marina Zea in Athens, between 2-3 pm. Enjoy a welcome drink and meet your crew and fellow passengers. Sail for Poros for a short 3 hours visit, before set sail to Poliegos, which is part of the Cyclades. Its name is of Italian origin granted by Venetian merchants to Thera, Greek name of this island steeped in history. Overnight at overseas. **(B) (D)**

DAY 4 (Saturday) POLIEGOS - FOLEGANDROS ISLAND

Breakfast onboard. Morning arrival in Poliegos, an uninhabited island known for its amazing beaches and turquoise waters. Morning swim stop followed by a BBQ on deck. Afternoon sailing to Folegandros, one of the most amazing and less known islands in the Aegean Sea. Walk the amazing Upper city and have the possibility to taste delicacies at traditional Greek taverns. Overnight in Folegandros. **(B) (L)**

DAY 5 (Sunday) **SANTORINI** (optional excursion)

Breakfast onboard. Santorini calling. We'll arrive early with plenty of time to explore the capital, Fira, as well as the smaller village of Oia with its blue-domed views over the caldera. This is the place to get those Instagram shots. Optional tour of the archaeological site, Akrotiri. As evening falls, enjoy the world-famous Santorini sunset with sundowners on deck. Tonight, it's time to show off your dance skills at our Greek Night. Overnight in Santorini. (B) (D)

DAY 6 (Monday) ANTIPAROS - PAROS ISLAND

Breakfast onboard. Today we'll sail to Paros, with a quick stop in a beautiful bay on neighboring Antiparos. Yes, you're welcome to dive in. In Paros, explore both the port city of Parikia, and Naoussa - a quaint, and incredibly photogenic village in the north. In the evening you will have ime to enjoy your dinner in a tavern overlooking the sunset. Overnight in Paros. (B) (D)

DAY 7 (Tuesday) DELOS - MYKONOS ISLAND (optinal excursion)

Breakfast onboard. Before waving ahoy to Mykonos, we'll stop for a few hours at sacred Delos. The island is an archaeological site, and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Join us on a guided tour before we sail to more hedonistic Mykonos. Here, the night is yours. Join the jet-set and vibe at the hottest bars and restaurants. Overnight in Mykonos - in case you don't want to leave the party early! (B) (D)

DAY 8 (Wednesday) SYROS ISLAND

Breakfast onboard. After a morning swim we will arrive in Syros, the capital of the Cycladic islands where you can enjoy one of its beautiful sandy beaches or have optional tour through town and enjoy the unique architecture of the buildings before having the chance for a culinary experience to taste authentic recipes of the Cycladic cuisine at small family tavernas. Time to have a fun night and show us your dancing skills during our famous Greek Night. Overnight in Syros. (B) (D)

DAY 9 (Thursday) KYTHNOS ISLAND – CAPE SOUNION – ATHENS

Breakfast onboard. We begin our journey back to Athens, with a last opportunity to jump into the inviting sea at Kolones Bay, Kythnos. Dry off as we sail towards Cape Sounion to view the Temple of Poseidon from the sundeck. On arrival back at Marina Zea, enjoy a Captain's Farewell Dinner before bedding down for one more night on board. (B) (D)
